


1 START HERE

How do I attach the stands to my TV? (not for wall mounting)

You'll need: Soft surface and Phillips screwdriver

Place your TV face-down on a cushioned, clean surface.

Align the screw holes on the TV stands with the holes on the bottom of your TV, then secure each stand to your TV with the provided screws.

How do I prepare my TV for wall mounting?

(not for use with a TV stand)

You'll need: Soft surface and Phillips screwdriver


Before you mount your TV, make sure that:

- You remove the stand legs
- The bracket supports the weight of your TV.

A Carefully place your TV face-down on a cushioned, clean surface.


VESA Mounting Pattern
VESA mount (mm): 200 x 200 – M6 type screws*
*minimum 10mm/maximum 14mm

Your TV has four VESA mounting holes on the back. If you attach a wall-mount bracket to the back of your TV, the bracket must be securely attached, using all four holes. If you do not use all four mounting holes, your TV may fall and cause property damage or personal injury. See the documentation that came with your wall-mount for complete mounting instructions.

On your TV's **Audio** menu, select **Audio Format / Audio Delay**, then press **ENTER**. Set the **Audio Format** option to **PCM**.

4 TURNING ON MY TV


When can I turn on my TV?

WHEN YOUR TV IS IN PLACE:

1 Plug the power cord into a power outlet.



2 Remove the remote control cover and install the batteries.




3 Press  on your remote control.
