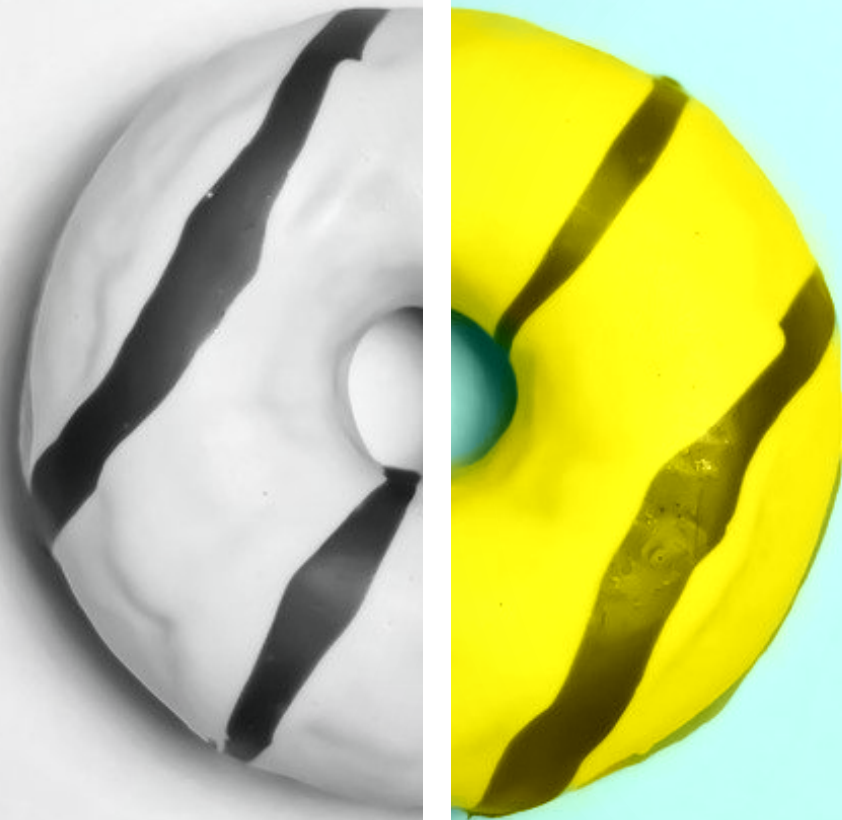

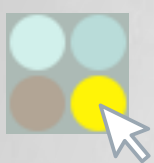

Select Pen tool



Pick a color



Draw a stroke.
Keep close to the
edge.



Avoid stepping
across the boundary.



Generate result

When you add a color to a single object, it spreads over the whole picture.

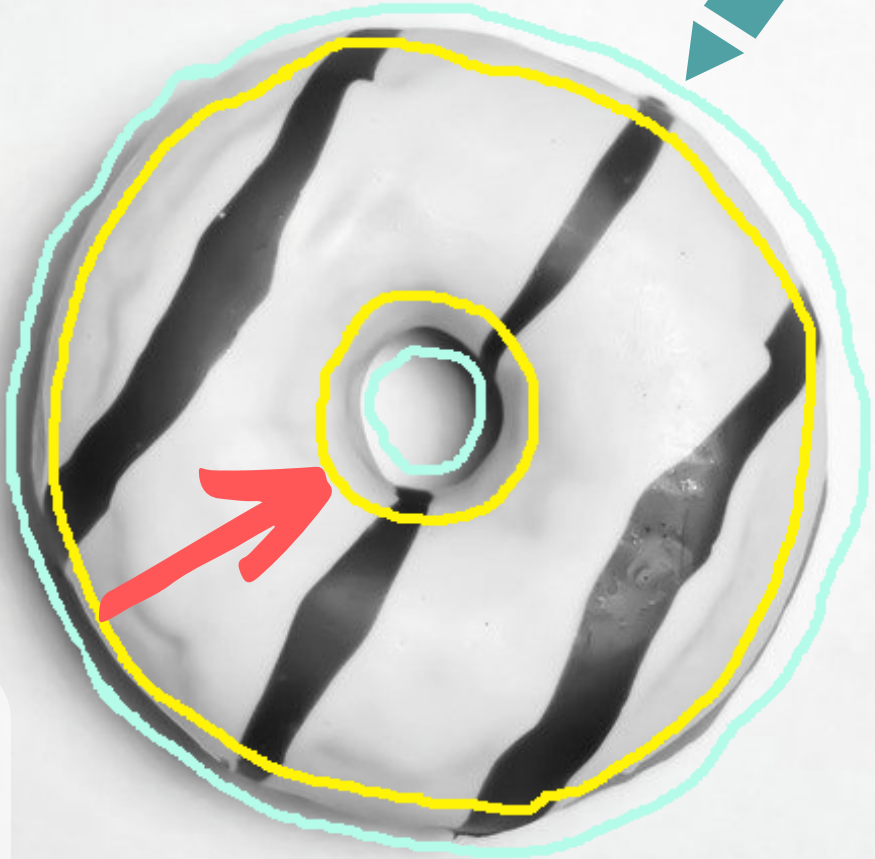


To enable **border detection**, add color to the neighbouring areas.



Pick a new color

Add a color mask to the background.



Mind internal borders!

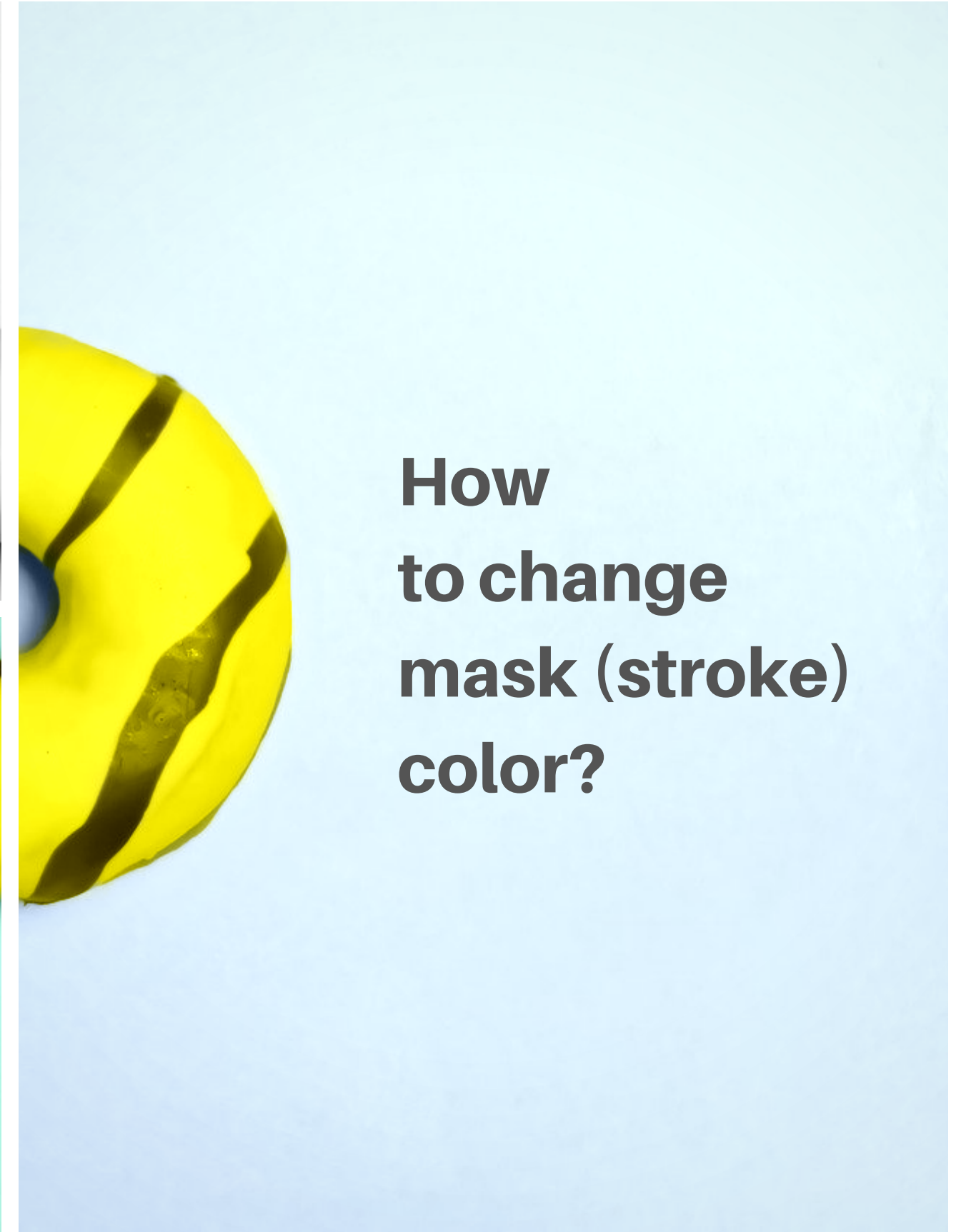


Generate result

Just look at how accurately CODIJY treated the border!



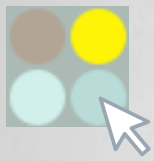
To fix occasional color spreading just add a stroke or two!

to change
mask (stroke)
color?**



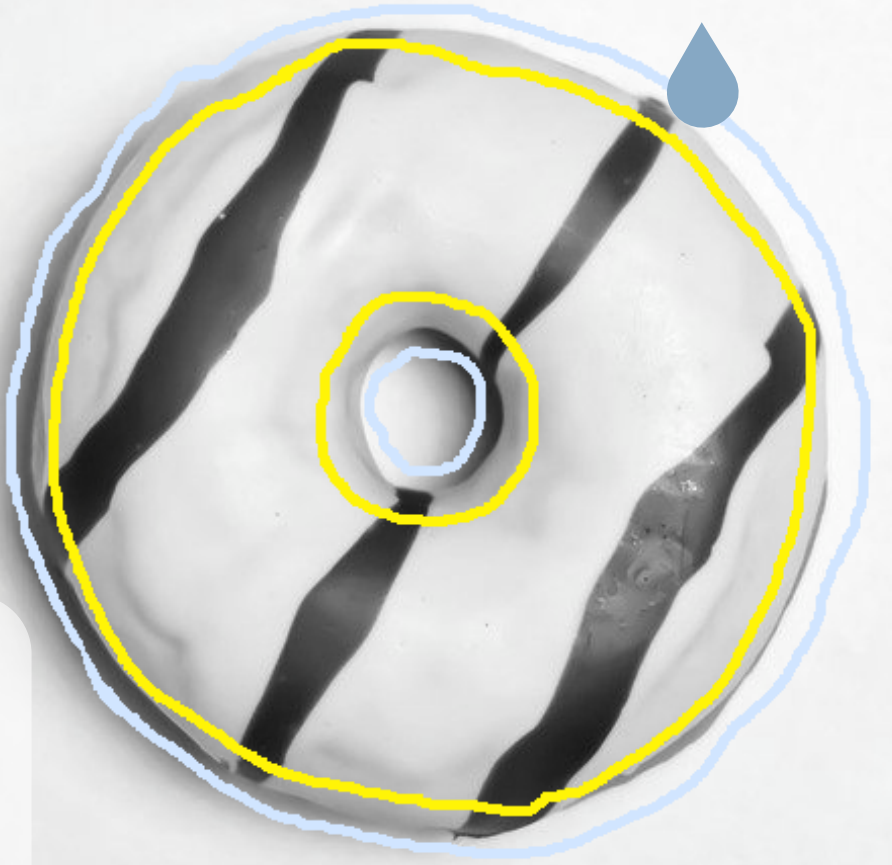
Select Repaint tool



Pick a new color



To adjust stroke color on the spot, use HSB Repaint, located next to the Repaint tool.



Fill the stroke with a new color



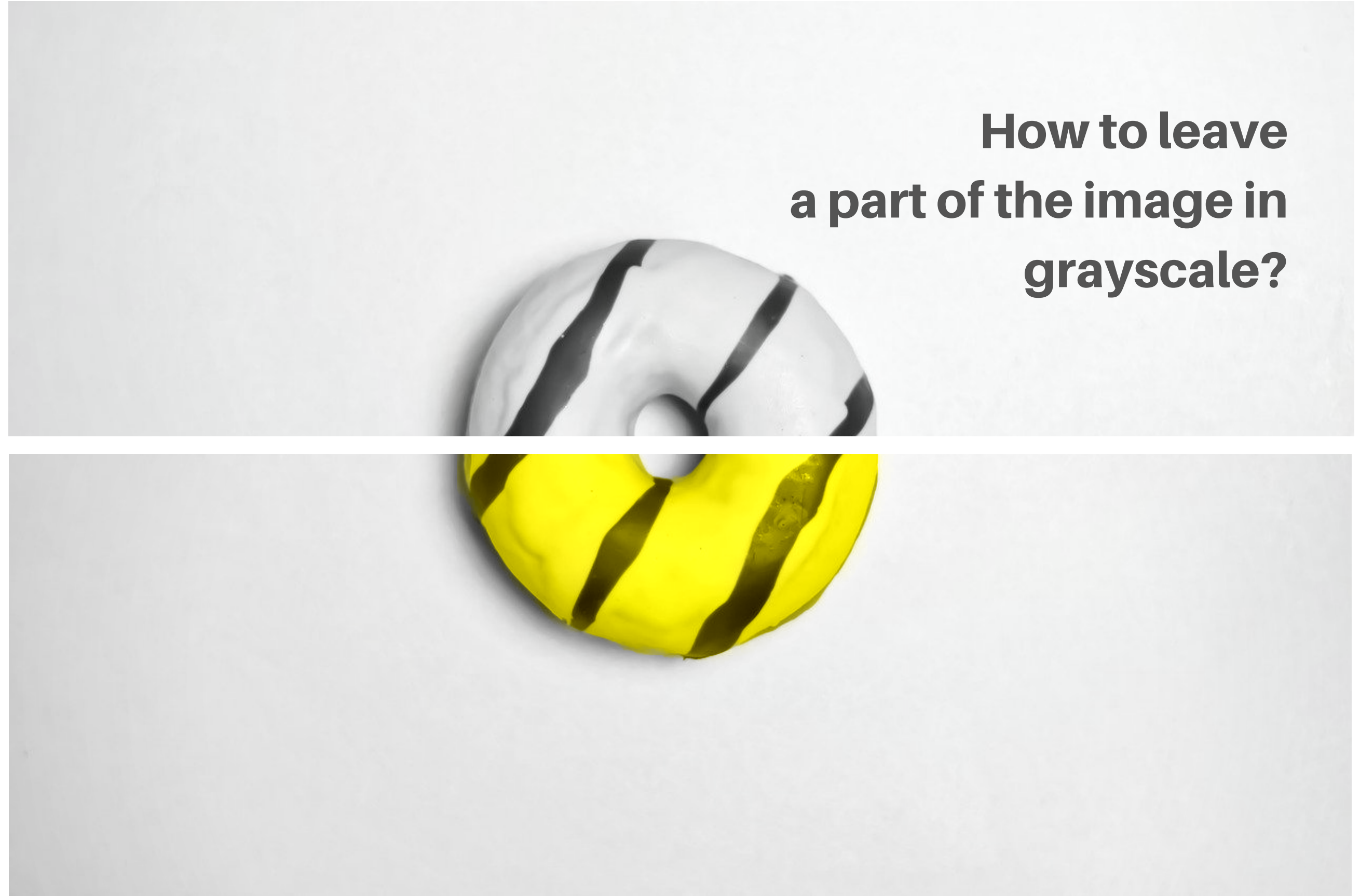
Generate result

The new color
seamlessly replaced
the old one!

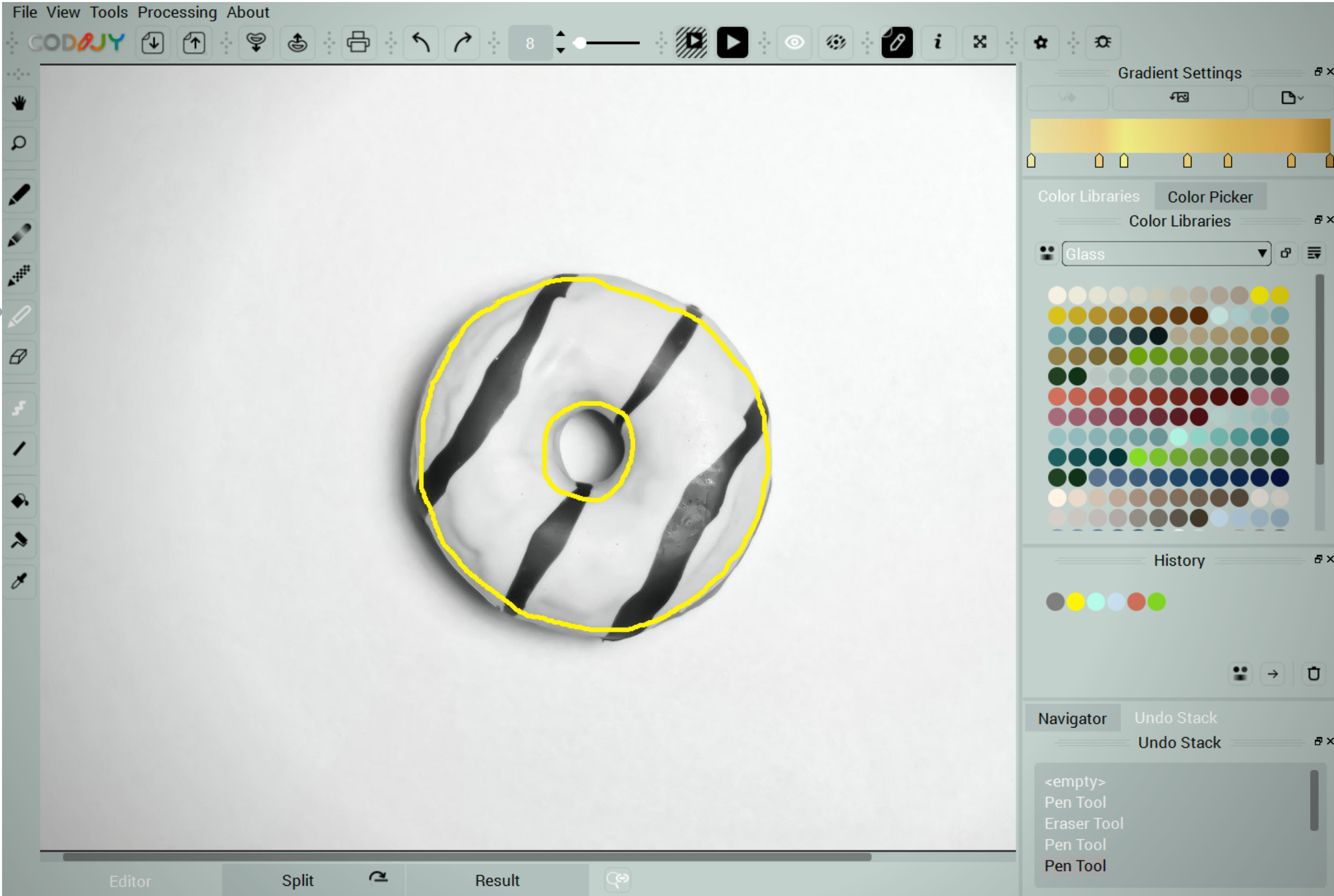

**How to leave
a part of the image in
grayscale?**

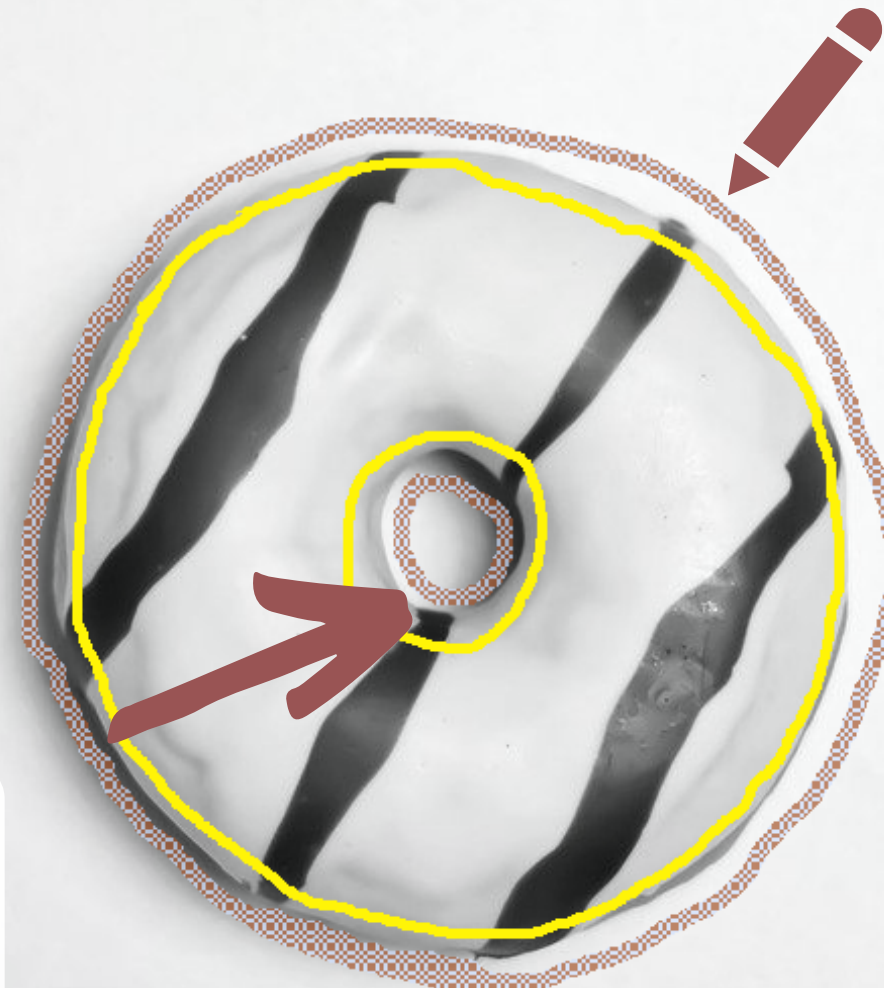


Decolor Pen





Select Decolor pen



Draw a decoloring stroke over the area, you wish to leave grayscale.



Don't forget about the internal border!

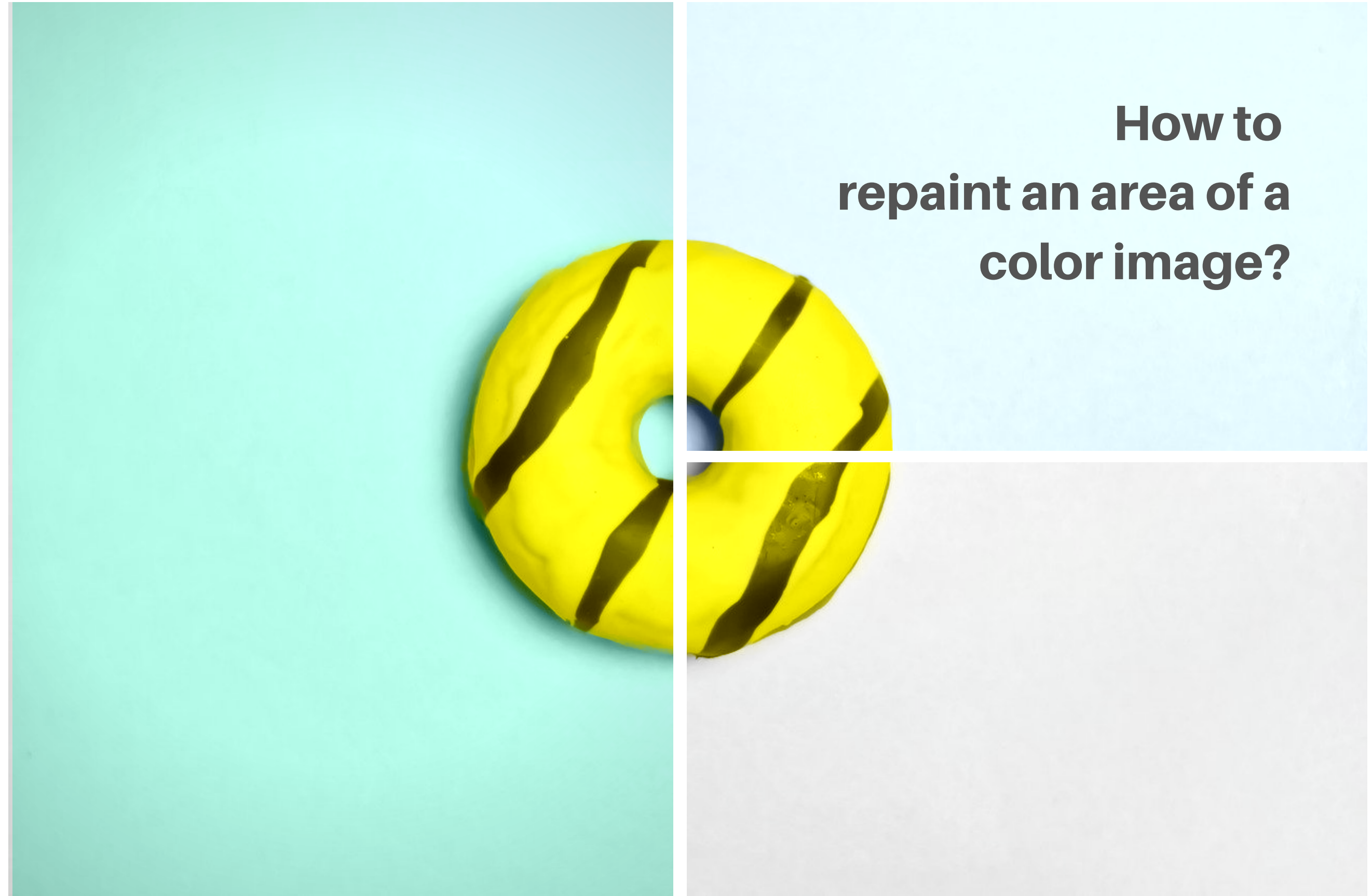


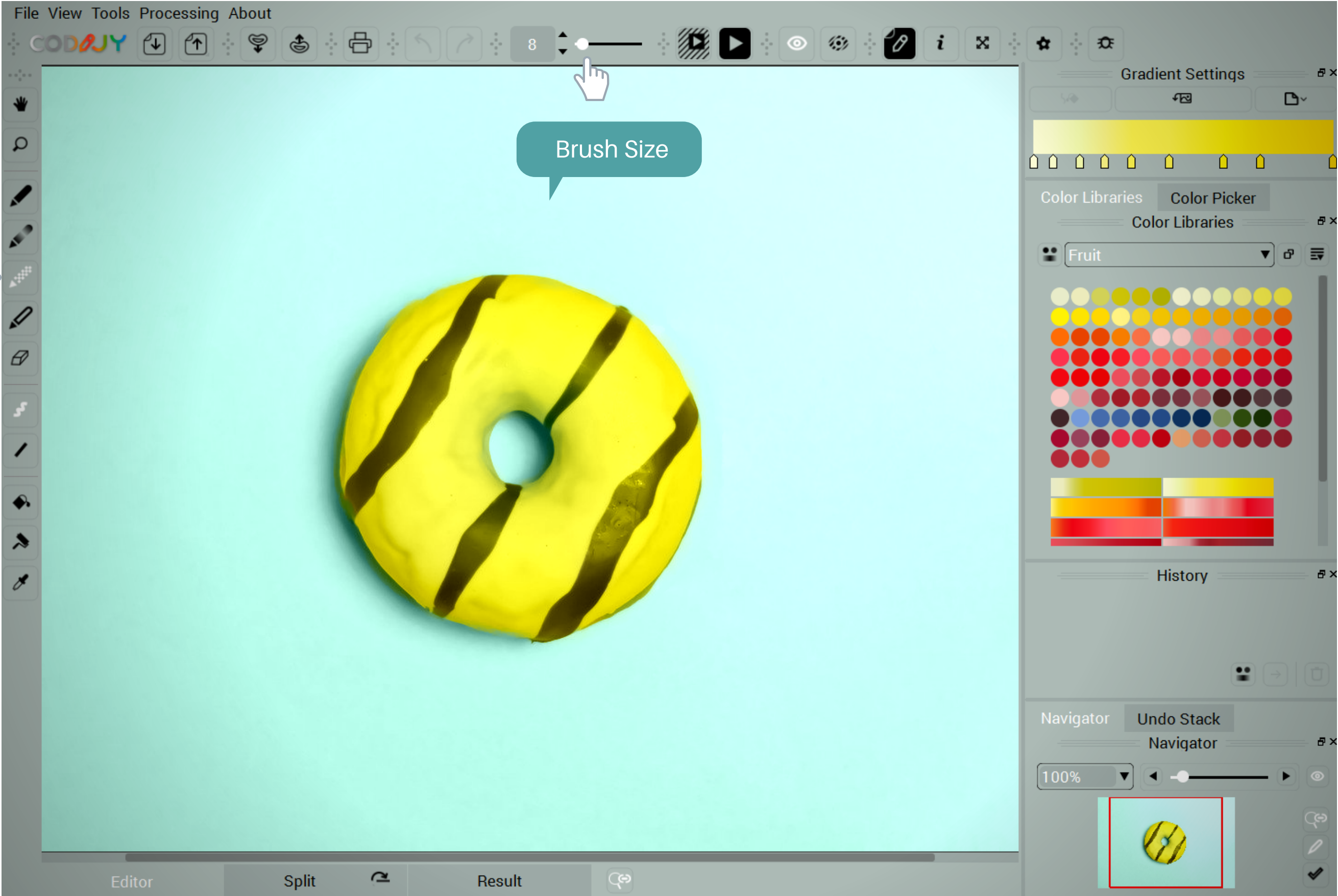
Generate result

the border between
color and grayscale
neat and tidy.



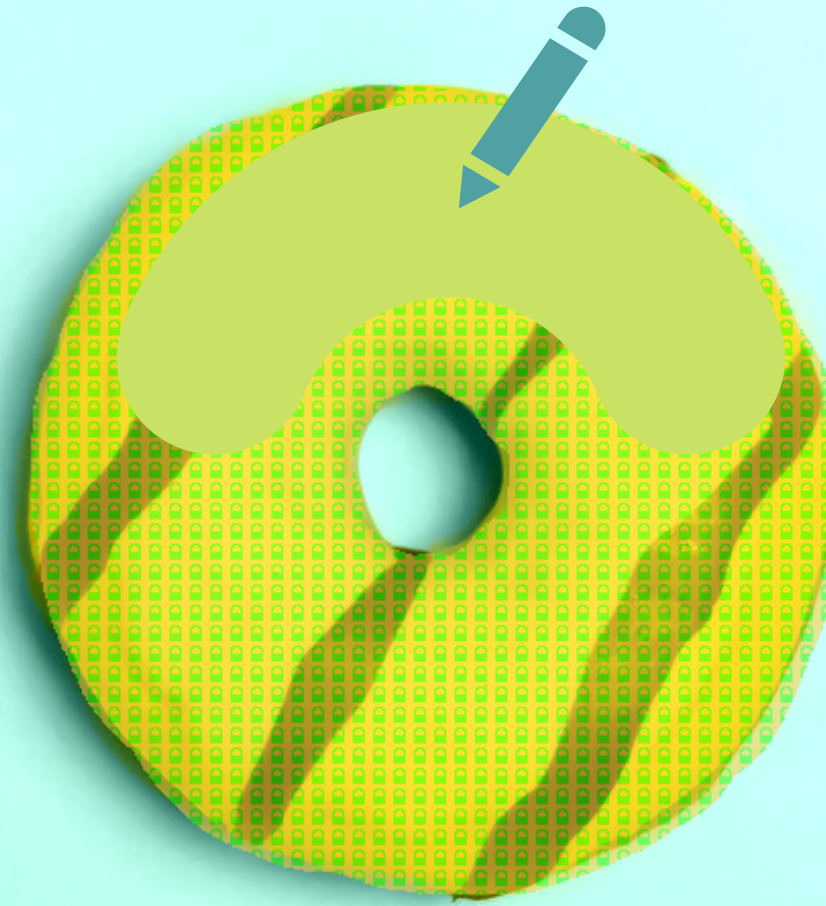
Let's see how to

Select Color Protection



Cover the object with
a protection mask,
to keep its original
color.



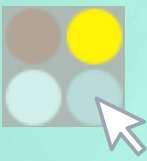
Larger brush
width lets cover
the whole area
with a few
movements!



Generate result



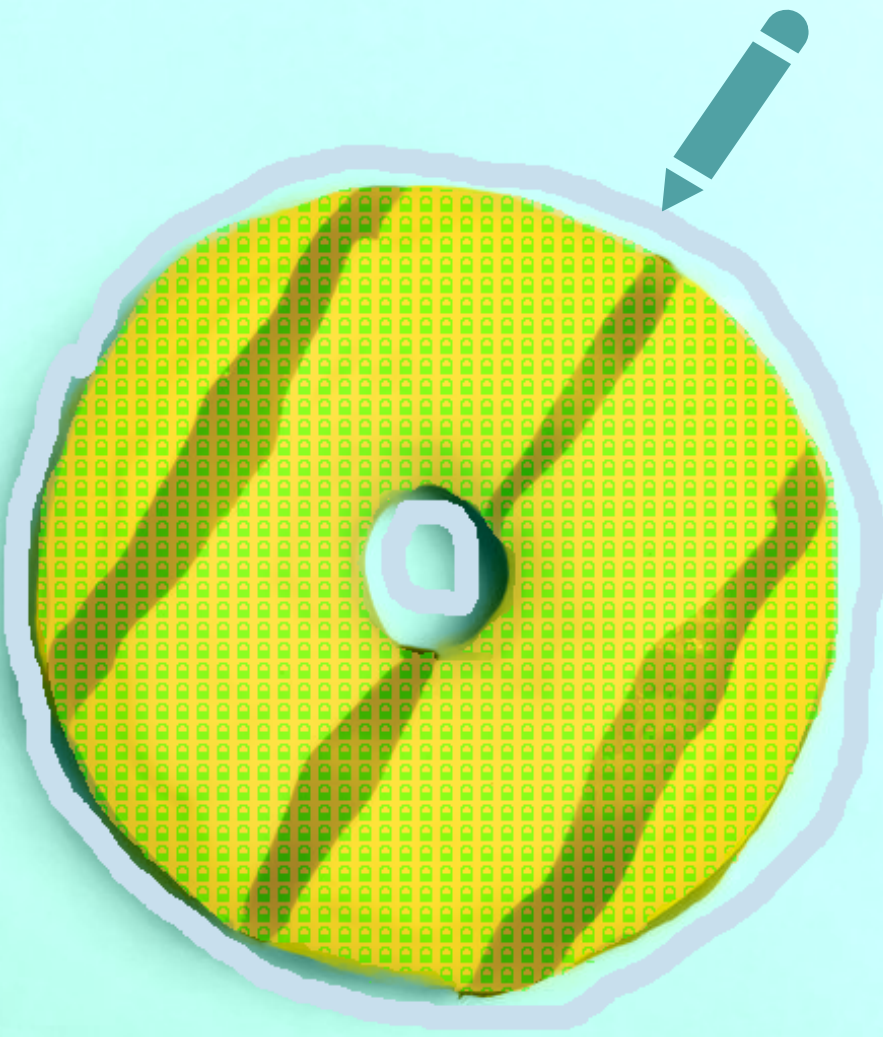
Select Pen Tool



Pick a color



To remove color from background use Decolor Pen instead.



Add a simple color stroke over the unprotected area.



Generate result

Look at the
refreshed color of
the background!
