





## Bluetooth Stereo Headset

RF-BTHP02



Congratulations on your purchase of the Rocketfish Mobile Bluetooth Stereo Headset. Listen to music wirelessly with Bluetooth audio devices and answer phone calls hands-free. You can use the headset to answer and make calls and to play music stored on your Bluetooth-enabled device.

### Turning the headset on and off

- To turn the headset on or off, press and hold the **Power** button for three seconds.

### Pairing the headset

- 1 Turn off the headset, then press and hold **Talk** for six seconds. Pairing mode is activated.
- 2 On your device, select either **RF-BTHP01** or **RF-BTHP02** from the list of discovered Bluetooth devices, then enter the password **0000** to pair the headset.

**Note:** After your headset has been successfully paired with your device, the headset will automatically connect to your device the next time the headset is turned on.

### Making phone calls

To:	Do this:
Voice dial	Press <b>Talk</b> once. (Some phones might not support this feature.)
Redial	Press <b>Talk</b> twice.
Answer a call	Press <b>Talk</b> once.
End a call	Press <b>Talk</b> once.
Refuse a call	While your phone is ringing, press <b>Play/Pause</b> .
Change the volume	Press + or - .
Transfer a call between connected devices	Double-click <b>Talk</b> .

## Playing music

To:	Do this:
<b>Play/Pause</b>	Press ►   to launch the phone's MP3 player and begin playing music. Press ►   to pause and resume playback. Press and hold ►   stop playback.
<b>Select a song</b>	Press and release ◀◀ or ▶▶.
<b>Rewind or fast forward a song</b>	While music is playing, press and hold ◀◀ or ▶▶. (Some phones may not support this feature.)
<b>Answer a call while playing music</b>	Press <b>Talk</b> , or press ►   to reject the call. Press <b>Talk</b> again to end the call. Music resumes playing after a call is rejected or ended.
<b>Change the volume</b>	Press + or -.

## Using EQ sound

There are three types of EQ sound effects:

- **Normal (EQ off)**
- **Bass**
- **Normal**
- **Soft**

The mode sequence is: **Bass – Normal – Soft – Normal – Bass** – etc. A “beep” sound indicates each mode change.

### To select a sound mode:

- While in play/pause mode, quickly press twice ►|| (play/pause).

### Resetting the headset

#### To reset your headset:

Press ►|| (play/pause), ◀◀ and ▶▶ buttons at the same time.

## LED indicator messages

Headset Status	LED Status
<b>Power on</b>	Blue LED is on
<b>Turning off</b>	Red LED dims and disappears
<b>Low battery</b>	Red LED blinks continuously
<b>Recharging</b>	Red LED stays on
<b>Recharging complete</b>	Blue LED stays on
<b>Pairing mode</b>	Blue and red LEDs flash rapidly
<b>Connection complete</b>	Blue LED blinks every three seconds
<b>Receiving a call</b>	Blue LED flashes rapidly
<b>Talking on the phone</b>	Blue LED brightens and dims repeatedly
<b>Playing music</b>	Blue LED brightens and dims repeatedly
