




Carefully remove and lay out all parts. Familiarize yourself with all exhibits and diagrams to facilitate the assembly of your crib


TOOLS REQUIRED : Allenkey (supplied)





Make sure the bolts are tightly locked against the washers during assembly. (Please add an extra $\frac{1}{2}$ revolution to all the bolts when using spring washer after tightening)

T2 - A- BRCM01- 00



- Insert nut 3/4" [20 mm] (L) through the top and bottom holes in headboard from the back side.
- Insert allenbolt 2 1/4" [55 mm] (F), spring washer (W) through the top and bottom holes in sideboard and connect to the headboard. Hand tighten only!
- Repeat STEP 1.1 for other sideboard.


STEP 1.2

- Insert barrel nut Ø5/8" x 5/8" (Ø15 mm x 15 mm) (M) into holes in stabilizer bar
- Connect stabilizer bar to the sideboard using (4 pcs) allenbolt 2 3/4" [70 mm] (G), spring washer (W)
- Tighten all bolts with allenkey (N)




- IF REFINISHING, USE A NON-TOXIC FINISH SPECIFIED FOR CHILDREN'S PRODUCTS.
- FOLLOW WARNINGS ON ALL PRODUCTS IN A CRIB. UPON COMPLETION OF ASSEMBLY, BE SURE ALL SCREWS, BOLT AND FASTENING DEVICES HAVE BEEN SECURELY TIGHTENED. A FREQUENT CHECK SHOULD BE MADE.
- WHEN STORING CRIB, USE CAUTION AS EXTREME CHANGE IN TEMPERATURE OR HUMIDITY CAN COMPROMISE THE CRIB, MAKING IT EXTREMELY DANGEROUS TO YOUR CHILD. STORE THE CRIB IN A CLEAN DRY PLACE.
- USE CAUTION WHEN A VAPORIZER OR HUMIDIFIER IS IN USE. ALWAYS AIM VAPOR AWAY FROM THE CRIB AS WELL AS ANY OTHER WOODEN FURNITURE. PROLONGED PERIODS OF HUMIDITY IN STORAGE AS WELL AS THE HOME CAN COMPROMISE THE CRIB.

DO NOT USE THIS CRIB IF THE ENCLOSED OR ATTACHED INSTRUCTIONS CANNOT BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO. DO NOT USE THIS CRIB IF THE CHILD IS ABLE TO CLIMB OUT UNAIDED OR IS TALLER THAN 90 CM. DO NOT PLACE CORDS, STRAPS OR SIMILAR ITEMS THAT COULD BECOME WOUND AROUND THE CHILD'S NECK IN OR NEAR THIS CRIB. ENSURE THAT THE SIDES ARE PROPERLY LATCHED OR LOCKED IN PLACE WHEN THE CRIB IS OCCUPIED. THE MATTRESS USED WITH THIS CRIB SHOULD NOT BE MORE THAN 15 CM THICK AND SHOULD BE OF SUCH LENGTH AND WIDTH THAT THE GAP BETWEEN THE MATTRESS AND THE SIDES OF THE CRIB IS NOT MORE THAN 3 CM WHEN THE MATTRESS IS PUSHED INTO THE CORNER OF THE CRIB.







These hardware are included in the CRIB



- Move Mattress spring to the lowest position as shown in FIG.2.
- Attach the allen bolt 1¹/₄" (30 mm) (J), spring washer (W) and nut 3/4" (20 mm) (L) on the lowest hole of side frame.

- Final position as shown in FIG.3.

THE DIMENSIONS OF THE MATTRESS SHALL BE TAKEN FROM SEAM TO SEAM OR EDGE TO EDGE WHERE APPROPRIATE.
- THE MINIMUM AGE OF THE INTENDED USER SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN 15 MONTHS AND THE MAXIMUM WEIGHT SHALL NOT BE GREATER THAN 50 LB (22.7 KG).
- **GUARDRAIL (SOLD SEPARATELY) MUST BE USED** WHEN CRIB USED AS A TODDLER BED TO AVOID THE FORMATION OF A GAP BETWEEN THE MATTRESS AND THE BED THAT COULD CAUSE AN ENTRAPMENT.
- DO NOT PLACE BED NEAR WINDOWS WHERE CORDS FROM BLINDS OR DRAPES MAY STRANGLE A CHILD.
