1. Introduction to Linxura Bluetooth Low Energy (BLE) controller mode.

The Linxura Bluetooth Low Energy (BLE) Controller Mode enables the Linxura device to connect to Bluetooth host devices, including Windows, macOS, iOS, and Android devices. Once connected, Linxura can control multiple applications on the host device. Please note, you don't need to add Linxura to the Linxura app to use this mode.

Supported BLE controller modes:



- 1 Click: Camera mode
- 2 Click: Media player mode
- 3 Click: Exit BLE mode
- 4 Click: Presentation mode

PRES: Presentation mode. Allows control of presentation apps on Windows, macOS, iOS, and Android devices.

MEDIA: Media player mode. Allows control of media player apps on Windows, macOS, iOS, and Android devices.

CAM: Allows control of camera apps on iOS and Android devices.

2. How does Linxura BLE Controller Mode work?

Step 1:

Press the left and right buttons simultaneously and hold for 3 seconds to enter Bluetooth pairing mode.



Step 2: The Linxura device displays the Bluetooth name on the screen.





Step 3:

Pair Linxura with your phone or computer.

Pairing Linxura with Windows PC

- 1. Ensure your Linxura is in Bluetooth pairing mode as described in Step 1
- 2. On your PC, go to Settings > Devices > Bluetooth & other devices.
- 3. Ensure Bluetooth is turned on.
- 4. Click on Add Bluetooth or other devices.
- 5. Select **Bluetooth** from the list.
- 6. Find and select your Linxura device from the list of available devices.
- 7. Follow any additional on-screen instructions to complete the pairing process.

Pairing Linxura with Mac

- 1. Ensure your Linxura is in Bluetooth pairing mode as described in Step 1
- 2. On your Mac, click on the **Apple menu** and select **System Preferences**.
- 3. Click on **Bluetooth**.
- 4. Ensure Bluetooth is turned on.
- 5. Find and select your Linxura device from the list of available devices.
- 6. Click **Connect**.
- 7. Follow any additional on-screen instructions to complete the pairing process.

Pairing Linxura with iOS (iPhone/iPad)

- 1. Ensure your Linxura is in Bluetooth pairing mode as described in Step 1
- 2. On your iOS device, go to **Settings** > **Bluetooth**.
- 3. Ensure Bluetooth is turned on.



- 4. Find and select your Linxura device from the list of available devices.
- 5. Follow any additional on-screen instructions to complete the pairing process.

Pairing Linxura with Android

- 1. Ensure your Linxura is in Bluetooth pairing mode as described in Step 1
- 2. On your Android device, go to **Settings** > **Connected devices** > **Bluetooth**.
- 3. Ensure Bluetooth is turned on.
- 4. Tap on Pair new device.
- 5. Find and select your Linxura device from the list of available devices.
- 6. Follow any additional on-screen instructions to complete the pairing process.

Step 4: After pairing, Linxura will display the options below. Choose a mode to start controlling.



Presentation mode button definition:





- 1 Click: Slideshow

 Double click: Black screen
- 2 Click: Next page
- 3 Click: Return to mode selection page
- 4 Click: Previous page
- 5 Rotate clockwise: Volume up Rotate counterclockwise: Volume down

Media player mode button definition:



- 1 Click: Play/Pause
- 2 Click: Next
- 3 Click: Return to mode selection page
- 4 Click: Previous
- 5 Rotate clockwise: Volume up Rotate counterclockwise: Volume down



Camera mode button definition:



- 1 Click: Take photo
- 2 Click: Return to mode selection page
- 3 Click: Record start/stop
