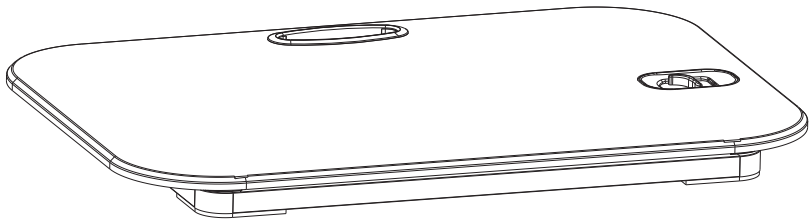
Pre-Assembly Preparation:

Please read through this instruction booklet before
beginning assembly of this item.

Two adults are recommended for assembly.

- Clear out the space for assembly and lay out all parts on Parts List, extra room will allow you to easily determine if all the pieces are present.
- Save all packing materials until assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding smaller parts or hardware.
- Keep small parts and pieces away from children and pets until fully assembled.
- Please check for any loose screws and tighten them before you use.

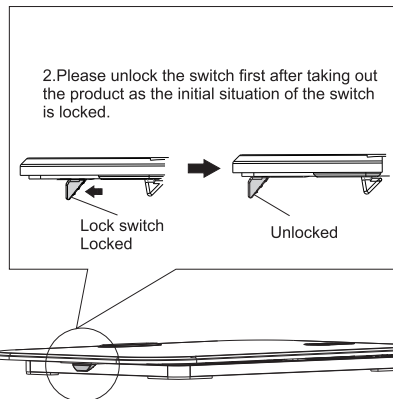
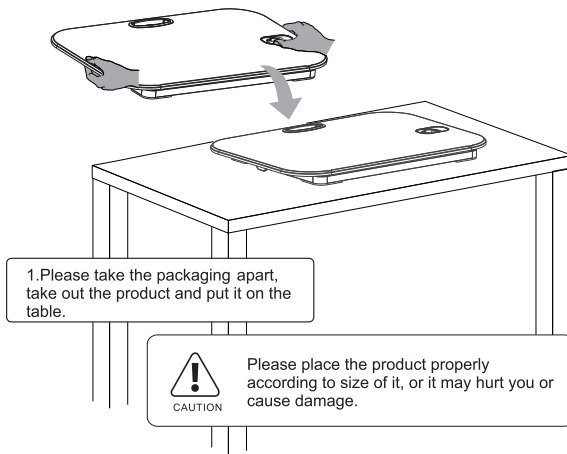
PARTS LIST

STEP 1

1. Ensure all parts have been removed from the carton and place on a protected surface or carpet.
2. Check all parts and hardware are the same as the "Parts List".



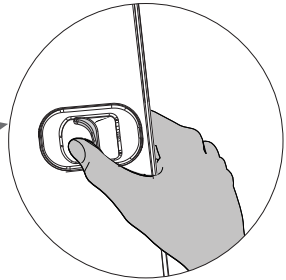
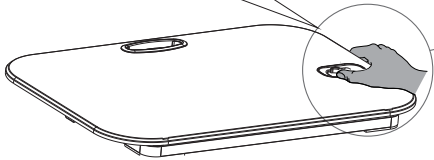
STEP 2

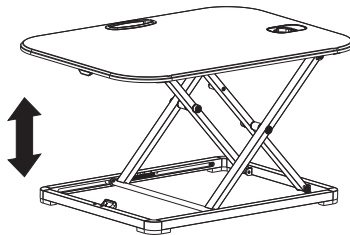
Please do not put hands near the supporting bars to avoid any injury while the desk is lifting up and down.

Please push the switch to adjust it to a desired height according to your situation.

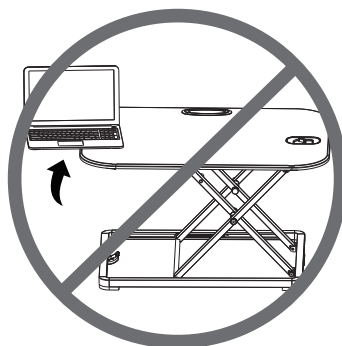
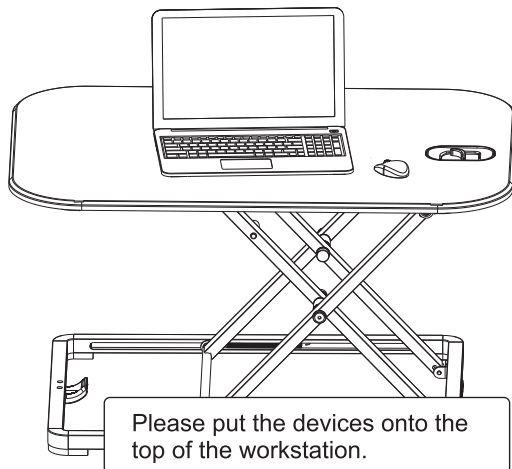


When lifting the workstation, push the switch by your thumb and push up the table while holding both sides of table edges. Then, it will go to the next height and lock automatically when you hear the noise.

When lowering the workstation, push the switch by your thumb and it will lower from current height, locking automatically when you hear the noise.

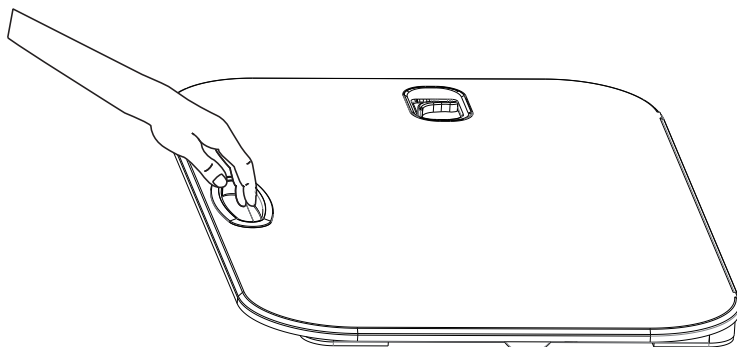
HOW TO TAKE THE WORKSTATION SAFELY

1 Close lock switch



Please push the lock switch inwards and make sure it is closed before taking it. Otherwise, it will flick open suddenly. This will decrease the potential for damage after carrying the workstation.

2 Take the workstation

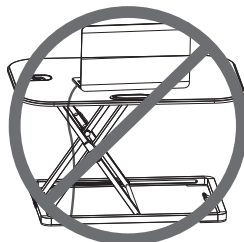

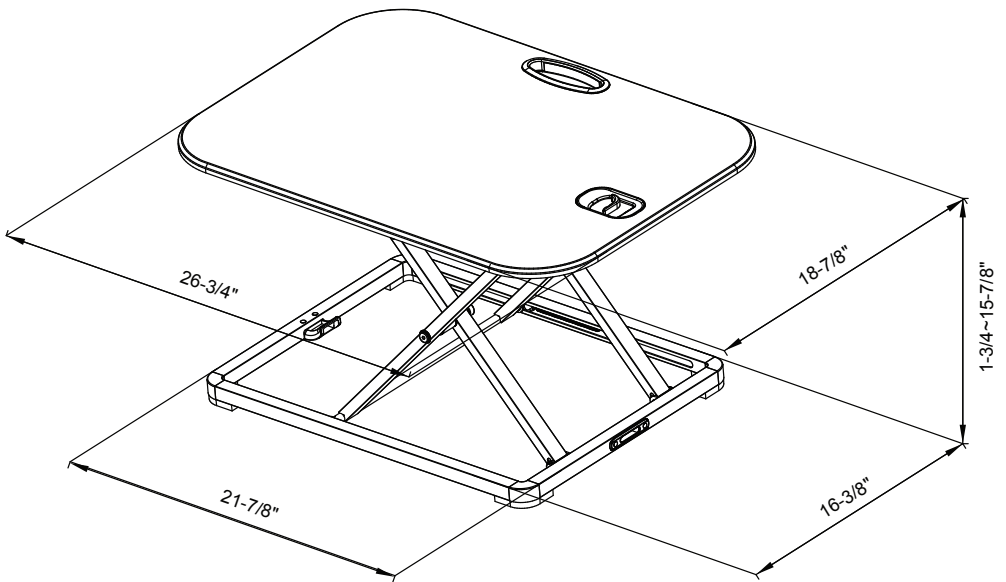

PRODUCT DIMENSION



LIMITED WARRANTY

The manufacturer's products are warranted against defects in material and workmanship while owned by the "Original Purchaser". The term "Original Purchaser" is defined as the party or entity which purchases this manufacturer's furniture from an authorized retailer as shown by the original sales receipt. This warranty does not apply to "as is" or previously owned products.

The manufacturer warrants its products to be free from defects in materials and workmanship (normal wear and tear, fading and stretching excepted), for one year from the date of purchase, except as provided below under the limited warranty. The exceptions or exclusions to this warranty are as follows:

1. Any warranty claim that is submitted after the limited warranty period, or without proper proof of purchase will not include the cost of parts, labor, or delivery.
2. This warranty shall not apply to the manufacturer's products which have been subjected to misuse, neglect, alteration, modification, or attachments, either caused by the Original Purchaser, shipping, storage, accident, fire, flood, or acts of God.

In the event of a defect in material or workmanship covered by this warranty, the manufacturer will repair or replace, at their discretion, without charge the warranted parts within a reasonable amount of time. We reserve the right to require damaged parts be returned to us upon request. Natural markings such as scars, brands, grain variations, wrinkles, color variations, etc. will be considered normal characteristics and not construed as defects.
