






<div> <div>TOZO®</div> <div>EN</div> </div> <div> <h3>1.0 Product Overview and Features</h3> <p>The packaging contains TOZO NC3 earbuds preinstalled with M size eardrop tips, a charging case, a USB-C cable, extra eartips, and instructions.</p> <p>Display Screen Reset Button</p> <p>XS L S XL M XXL</p> <p>User Manual Quick Guide</p> <p>Active Noise Cancellation Radio Hole Indicator Light Touch Area Charging Pin Calling MIC</p> </div>	<div> <div>TOZO®</div> <div>EN</div> </div> <div> <h3>2.0 Wearing Guide</h3> <p>For a better fit, adjust the wearing angle slightly after putting on the earbuds to push them gently into the ear canal.</p> <h3>3.0 Pairing and Connectivity</h3> <p>Remove the earbuds from the case. They'll reconnect to the last paired device if paired before. If not paired or pairing cancelled, the earbuds enter pairing mode with a slow white light blink. Search [TOZO NC3] on your phone and connect.</p> <h3>4.0 Power on/off</h3> <h4>4.1 Earbuds auto power on</h4> <p>Open the cover and take out the earbuds, and the earbuds will automatically turn on.</p> <h4>4.2 Earbuds auto power off</h4> <p>Placing the earbuds back in the charging case and closing the cover will automatically turn them off.</p> <h4>4.3 Another method of earbuds power on/off</h4> <p>Hold L or R for 3 seconds will turn on when earbuds power off. Hold L or R for 5 seconds will turn off when not playing media. The earbuds will automatically turn off if they remain disconnected for more than 5 minutes.</p> <p>3S 5S Power on Power off</p> </div>	<div> <div>TOZO®</div> <div>EN</div> </div> <div> <h3>5.0 Operation and Controls</h3> <h4>5.1 Wearing both earbuds</h4> <p>L R</p> <p>X2 X2 Double tap "L" touch area to switch to previous song. Double tap "R" touch area to switch to next song.</p> <p>X1 X1 Tap the "L" or "R" touch area to play or pause music.</p> <p>Hold Hold Long press the "L" to lower the volume when music playing. Long press the "R" to increase the volume when music playing.</p> <h4>5.2 Wearing one earbud</h4> <p>L L/R R</p> <p>X2 X1 X2 Double tap "L" touch area to switch to previous song. Tap the "L" or "R" touch area to play or pause music. Double tap "R" touch area to switch to next song.</p> </div>	<div> <div>TOZO®</div> <div>EN</div> </div> <div> <h3>5.3 Calling Control</h3> <p>L R</p> <p>X1 X1 On an incoming call, tap the "L" or "R" touch area to answer. While calling, press and hold the "L" or "R" touch area for 2s to hang up. On an incoming call, press and hold the "L" or "R" touch area for 2s to reject the call.</p> <p>Hold Hold During dialing, press and hold the left or right touch area for 2s to cancel the call.</p> <h3>5.4 Active Noise Cancellation</h3> <p>The Active Noise Cancellation function is not available when using a single earbud.</p> <p>L R</p> <p>X1 X1 Tap "L" once to switch between Transparency Mode and Active Noise Cancellation Mode. Triple tap "L" to switch back to Normal Mode.</p> <h3>5.5 Voice Assistant</h3> <p>R</p> <p>X3 X3 When using single or double earbuds, triple tap "R" to wake up voice assistant.</p> <h3>5.6 Low-latency Mode</h3> <p>L</p> <p>X5 X5 Take out earbuds, connect to phone, tap left 5x for low-latency, tap again to exit. The low-latency mode is off by default.</p> </div>	<div> <div>TOZO®</div> <div>EN</div> </div> <div> <h3>5.7 Reset</h3> <p>If only one earbud is working, please follow these steps:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Check if there is dirt on the charging pins of the earbuds. If so, please clean them. 2. If the issue of one earbud not working persists after cleaning, place the earbuds in the charging case and close the lid. Hold down the reset button on the charging case for 10 seconds, and then wait for another 10 seconds for the reset to complete. After the reset, take out the earbuds and they should be ready for normal use. If this method does not work, repeat the steps above once again. <h3>5.8 Forced Pairing Mode</h3> <p>To force pair your earbuds, ensure both earbuds are in the case and press the reset button for 3s. The earbuds will no longer reconnect to previous devices and will automatically enter pairing mode when taken out.</p> <p>Reset Button</p> <h3>6.0 Active Noise Cancellation Mode and Transparency Mode</h3> <h4>6.1 Active Noise Cancellation Mode</h4> <p>With Active Noise Cancellation, TOZO NC3 earbuds detect external sounds through an outward-facing microphone and counter them with anti-noise, cancelling them before they reach your ears. Additionally, an inward-facing microphone listens for unwanted internal sounds, which are also negated by the anti-noise feature.</p> <p>Active Noise Cancellation</p> </div>	<div> <div>TOZO®</div> <div>EN</div> </div> <div> <h3>6.2 Transparency Mode</h3> <p>Transparency Mode enhances the voice frequency band, improving awareness of your surroundings, so you can hear what's around you without removing your earbuds. Both Active Noise Cancellation and Transparency Mode work best when your TOZO NC3 fits and is worn properly.</p> <p>Transparency Mode</p> <h3>6.3 Active Noise Cancellation Mode Off</h3> <p>Active Noise Cancellation Off Mode is the default mode.</p> <h3>7.0 Charging and Battery</h3> <h4>7.1 Charging Case Display On/Off</h4> <p>By default, the display is off. It will activate for 5s and then automatically shut off after opening the case to remove the earbuds, placing the earbuds back in the case, or pressing the reset button once. During charging, the display stays on continuously.</p> <p>Charging Case Display On/Off</p> <h4>7.2 Charging Case Indicators</h4> <p>When both earbuds are placed in the case, the charging lights on both sides and the case battery light flash for 5s to show charging and battery status. With one earbud, it displays its charging status and case battery level.</p> <p>Charging Case Indicators</p> <h3>7.3 Charging</h3> <p>The charging case won't charge earbuds when below 5%, but it can still power them off. Charge before 5% to avoid interruption. Both earbuds and case need 2 hours to charge fully.</p> </div>
