

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

Problem

Possible Solutions

The vehicle does not move.

- Charge the battery. (Charge battery after each use.)
- Check all electrical connections.
- The thermal fuse may have been activated due to excessive weight or rough driving conditions. Wait at least 30 seconds, and the vehicle will reset itself.

The vehicle begins to run slow.

- Charge the battery. (Charge battery after each use.)
- Only allow one rider at a time. DO NOT exceed child weight limit: 66 lbs (30 kg).
- Drive on level ground.
- Battery may be old or not accepting a full charge. The battery will last from 1 to 3 years depending on care, use and environment.
- Contact Customer Service for replacement battery information.

The vehicle runs erratically.

- There may be a problem with the thermal fuse, or you may have a damaged battery. Contact Customer Service.

The charger feels warm when in use.

- This is normal.

The gears are very loud and/or make a grinding noise.

- The gears may be broken. Contact Customer Service.

- When the Little Tikes Dirt Digger is moving do not switch from forward to reverse or reverse to forward. The digger needs to be stationary when operating the forward or reverse switch function.
- Do not manually push or pull the Digger to prevent rollover risk.
- The Little Tikes® Cozy Powered Dirt Digger™ should be checked regularly by an adult – it is recommended once every two weeks. It is important to check the wires, plugs, electrical, housing, steering systems & fastening. If any problems are found - stop use immediately until the issue is fully resolved.
- If spare parts are required- they should only be changed or installed by an adult.
- After use, it is recommended this product is switched to the "off" position to ensure circuit safety.

Battery MUST be charged for 12 hours prior to first use!





Safety Switch



This product had been installed with a safety switch.

If the digger is overloaded or used improperly the power will automatically cut off within 10-20 seconds.

To avoid the safety switch being activated please refrain from the following:

- (1). Do not overload - maximum weight limited of the digger is 66 lbs (30 KG).
- (2). Do not attach a trailer behind or tow anything behind the digger.
- (3). Do not expose to liquid or rain.
- (4). Do not adjust vehicle's circuit structure.

Charging the battery



- (1). As pictured, plug the charger into the vehicle's charging hole.
- (2). Plug the battery charger plug into the power source.

Charger should be regularly examined for potential hazards. DO NOT use if there is damage to the cord, plug, or housing.

SAFE BATTERY USAGE

- Use only the type battery recommended for the unit.
- Battery should be replaced only by an adult.
- Insert battery with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not short-circuit battery.
- When not used for an extended time, remove battery to prevent possible leakage and damage to the unit.
- Rechargeable battery is to be recharged only by an adult.
- Do not recharge non-rechargeable battery.
- Exhausted battery is to be removed from the toy.
- Do not dispose of battery in fire as it may leak or explode.






BEGINNING RIDER - LOW SPEED



ADVANCED RIDER - HIGH SPEED




Do not suddenly move the shifter to reverse when running forward to avoid falls or collisions.




Exploded view





Product Assembly




(1) Cut plastic zip tie on left & right sides gear box before product assemble.




(2) remove shaft sleeve protection & 10mm nuts from wheel axle.




(4) Remove battery cover panel 2 screws and panel.




(6) Assemble the battery cover panel with 2 screws, then attach seat with 2 - ⑯ - 4x16mm screws.




(3) Attach wheels as shown, front wheels first. When tighten the rear axle wheel nut be sure to tighten both the left and right sides at the same time, this will allow to properly tighten and stop the axle from spinning in place.




(5) Connect the red wire plug to the battery as shown.




(8) Snap the roll bar into body, attach with 2 - ⑯ - 4x16mm screws.




(9) Snap light and smoke stack into body as shown.




(10) Connect left and right lifting arms ④ with pipe frame with 4 - ⑯ - 4x16mm screws.




(12) Align lifting arm assembly with the push blade 5 holes. Attach with 2 - ⑥ - bolt and 2 - ⑥ - 4x12mm screws.



(11) Remove 2 - ⑥ - bolt and 2 - ⑥ - 4x12mm screws, push the rod into the middle hole of the bucket into the iron pole, and then push the bucket into the slot on the front part of the lifting arm.



(13) Add the assembled lifting arm onto the digger's body by inserting the arms onto the corresponding position as shown. Insert the lift arm axle ⑯, place ⑯ - 8mm washer and ⑯ - 8mm nut on each end and tighten with wrench ⑯.



(7) Remove 5x40mm screw and 5mm nut ⑯ from steeringwheel first, then insert the steering wheel into the steering column, with screw and nut ⑯ to lock the steering rod to the steering wheel.
