



TOOLS REQUIRED


- Panel removal tool Phillips screwdriver
- Cutting tool Scribe tool

Attention! Let the vehicle sit with the key out of the ignition for a few minutes before removing the factory radio. When testing the aftermarket equipment, ensure that all factory equipment is connected before cycling the key to ignition.

DASH DISASSEMBLY

- Engage the parking brake, then place the gear selector in the lowest position.
- Unclip, unplug, and remove the dashboard trim panel. (Figure A)
- **3.** Depress the tabs securing the radio and slide the radio out in one motion. Unplug and remove the radio.




KIT PREPARATION

- **1.** Place the **cut template** over the dashboard trim panel. (Figure A)
- Using a scribe tool, score the area in the radio section to be cut. (Figure B)
- Remove the **cut template**, then cut the scored area with a cutting tool.
- **4.** Clip the **radio trim panel** onto the dashboard trim panel. (Figure C)





KIT ASSEMBLY

- 1. Secure the **radio brackets** to the radio using the screws supplied with the radio. (Figure A)
- 2. Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna connector in the dash and complete all necessary connections to the radio. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra and/or Axxess. Test the radio for proper operation.
- **3.** Clip the radio assembly into the dash.
- 4. Reassemble the dash in reverse order of disassembly to complete the installation.
