



Setting up your mouse

Setting up your keyboard


- Plug the keyboard into an available USB port on your computer.
Windows automatically finds your keyboard and installs the appropriate driver.

- Wipe the mouse and keyboard with a damp, lint-free cloth.

Keyboard features



Hot keys

Icon	Function	Description
	Sleep	Press to put your computer into sleep mode.
	E-mail	Press to open your e-mail program and to check your e-mail.
	Browser	Press to start your default Web browser. If your Web browser is already open, pressing this key takes you to the home page.
	Play/Pause	Press to play or pause music or video. Press again to resume.
	Stop	Press to stop playing music or video.
	Volume down	Press to decrease the volume. Hold down to decrease the volume quickly.
	Volume up	Press to increase the volume. Hold down to increase the volume quickly.
	Mute	Press to turn the sound off.
	Calculator	Press to open the calculator.

- Make sure your computer meets the system requirements.
- Make sure your mouse and keyboard USB cables are securely attached to the USB ports on your computer.
- Only use the mouse on a clean, flat, non-slippery surface to ensure smooth and accurate cursor action.
