






Installing the stand

1 Carefully place your TV screen face-down on a cushioned, clean surface to protect the screen from damages and scratches.

indicator control sensor

- 2 Secure the stand to the stand column with the provided four screws and
- 3 Slide the stand column into the slot in the bottom of the TV/Blu-ray combo, then secure the stand column with the eight provided screws.

4 Secure the stand cover (included) to the TV/Blu-ray combo with the two screws provided.




Installing a wall-mount bracket

- 1 Carefully place your TV face-down on a cushioned, clean surface to protect the screen from damages and scratches.
- 2 Remove the two screws securing the stand cover to the TV, then remove
- 3 Remove the eight screws holding the TV/Blu-ray DVD combo to its stand, then remove the stand.
- 4 Secure the wall-mount bracket to the back of your TV using the screws provided with the wall mount. Wall-mount bracket and screws are not provided.

Setting up your remote control

1 Press down on the battery compartment cover lock, then remove the battery compartment cover.





- 2 Insert two AA batteries into the battery compartment. Make sure that the + and – symbols on the batteries align with the + and – symbols in the battery compartment.
- **3** Replace the cover.








Connecting a Home

Connecting to a wired router Connect an Ethernet cable (CAT5 or better with an RJ45 connector) to the **ETHERNET** jack on theback of your TV/Blu-ray combo and to an Ethernet jack on a router.



Turning on your TV for the first time

To set up your TV:

- **1** Make sure that you have:
- Installed the remote control batteries.
- Connected an antenna, cable TV, or satellite TV.
- Connected the power cord.
- 2 Press **(b)** (power) on the remote control to turn on your TV. The *Choose Your Menu language* screen opens.



3 Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight the language you want, then press ENTER. The Choose your Time Setting screen opens.



- **4** Press **△** or **▼** to highlight **Mode**, then press **⋖** or **▶** to select **Manual** (to set the date and time manually) or Auto (to set the date and time automatically from a TV signal source based on the time zone your select).
- 5 Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight an option, then press ◀ or ▶ to adjust the option.

Mode—Select **Auto** or **Manual**. If you select Auto, the date and time are set based on a time signal received from a digital TV channel. If you select Manual, you can adjust the date and time.

Time Zone—Select the time zone.

Daylight Savings—Select On or Off.

Year—Select the current year.

Month—Select the current month.

Day—Select the current day.

Time—When Time is highlighted, press ◀ or ▶ to move the cursor from field to field, then press ▲ or ▼ to change the value in the field.

- **6** Press **ENTER**. The *Choose Your Picture Mode* screen opens.
- 7 Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight Home Mode or Retail Mode, then press ENTER. If you selected **Retail Mode**, a message appears "If you select **Retail Mode**, then Energy Savings is not realized." If you select **No**, press **ENTER**.

The Choose Your Picture Mode screen reopens. Go back to step 6. If you select Yes, press ENTER. The Choose Your TV Source screen opens.



8 Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight Antenna, Cable, or Cable/Satellite Box (if your cable TV uses a box, select **Cable/Satellite Box**), then press **ENTER**. If you chose Antenna or Cable, your TV/Blu-ray combo automatically starts scanning for channels available in your viewing area. If you chose Cable/Satellite box, your TV/Blu-ray combo does not need to scan for channels. During auto channel search, your TV/Blu-ray combo searches for digital channels first. When the digital channel search is complete, a message appears asking if you want to search for analog channels. Select Yes to continue searching for analog channels, or select **No** to stop searching for channels.



9 To watch TV, press INPUT, then press INPUT repeatedly or press ▲ or ▼ to highlight **TV** in the input source list, then press **ENTER**.

Selecting the video input source

 Press INPUT, then press INPUT repeatedly or press ▲ or ▼ to highlight the video source, then press **ENTER**.







Connecting to the Internet to download BD-Live content


Your TV/Blu-ray combo has an Ethernet jack and a built-in Wi-Fi antenna. You can connect to the Internet using a:

Wired connection (Ehternet jack)
Wireless connection (Wi-Fi antenna)

Configuring a wired Internet connection

To configure a wired Internet connection:

- 1 Press **ENTER**. The *Settings* menu opens.
- 2 Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight Network, then press ENTER. The Network menu opens.
- 3 Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight **Wired**, then press **ENTER**. The *IP Settings* screen opens.




- 4 Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight IP Mode, then press ENTER.
- 5 Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight an IP mode, then press **ENTER**. You can select:
- Off—Disables the network interface.
- **Manual**—Lets you manually configure network settings, such as IP address, subnet mask, and gateway settings
- **Dynamic**—Uses DHCP to automatically obtain an IP address.
- 6 Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight **Apply**, then press **ENTER**. To cancel manual setup, select **Cancel**, then press **ENTER**.
- 7 Press ◀to go to the previous menu. You are ready to access the Internet.


Configuring a wireless Internet connection

To configure a wireless Internet connection:

- 1 Press ENTER. The Settings menu opens.
- 2 Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight Network, then press ENTER. The Network menu opens
- 3 Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight Wireless, then press ENTER. The list of wireless options opens.



4 Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight **IP Settings**, then press **ENTER**. The *IP Settings* screen opens.



- 5 Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight IP Mode, then press ENTER.
- 6 Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight an IP mode, then press ENTER. You can select:
- Off—Disables the network interface.
- Manual Lets you manually configure network settings, such as IP address, subnet mask, and gateway settings
- **Dynamic**—Uses DHCP to automatically obtain an IP address.
- 7 Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight Apply, then press ENTER. To cancel manual setup, select Cancel, then press ENTER.
- 8 Press ◀ to go to the previous menu. The method you use to connect to a wireless network depends on the network type. For information about how to connect to a wireless network and access the Internet, see your User Guide.



Registering your TV/Blu-ray combo with Netflix


To register your TV/Blu-ray combo with Netflix:



- 1 Press INPUT, press ▲ or ▼to highlight BLU-RAY, then press ENTER. The Settings menu opens.
- 2 Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight **Connected**, then press **ENTER**. The *Connected* screen opens.
- 3 Press ▲ or ▼to highlight **NETFLIX**, then press **ENTER**. A message asks "Are you a member of Netflix?".
- **4** Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight **Yes**, then press **ENTER**.
- **5** Follow the on-screen instructions to activate your TV/Blu-ray combo, and link it to your Netflix account. Your TV/Blu-ray combo will be registered, and you can begin enjoying movies from Netflix.

Registering your TV/Blu-ray combo with Pandora

To register your TV/Blu-ray combo with Pandora:



- 1 Press **INPUT**, press ▲ or ▼to highlight **BLU-RAY**, then press **ENTER**. The *Settings* menu opens.
- 2 Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight **Connected**, then press **ENTER**. The *Connected* menu opens
- **3** Press ▲ or ▼to highlight Pandora, then press **ENTER**. Then follow the on-screen instructions to operate.
