### Using your charging pad



# Troubleshooting

#### Device is not charging or charges slowly.

- Make sure that your 20 W or higher power adapter (not included) is connect to a working power outlet.
- Make sure that your device is positioned in the center of your charging pad.
- Make sure that there are no other objects on the charging pad.
- Try removing your device's case.
- Make sure that your device is Qi-enabled.Make sure that the AC wall adapter you are using is 20 W or
- higher.Using the phone while it is charging will make it charge more slowly.
- Your device may charge more slowly with the charging pad than a charging cable. This is normal.

It is normal for devices to get warm while charging.
