3. This product is intended for home use only. Do not use this product in a commercial, rental, or institutional setting.
4. Keep children under age 12 and pets away from this product.
5. This product should not be used by persons weighing more than 300 pounds (136 kg). No more than 30 pounds (14 kg) of weights should be used with this product.
6. Use this product only on a clean, level, non-slip surface. Make sure that there is adequate clearance around this product.
7. Keep this product away from sharp objects, heat sources, and direct sunlight. Do not leave this product in automobiles where it may be exposed to high temperatures.
8. Inspect this product before each use for worn spots, cracks, and foreign objects. Do not use this product or try to repair it if it is damaged.
9. Inflate this product only as described in this manual. Improper inflation may result in damage to this product and will void the warranty.

USING THE STABILITY DISK

The Stability Disk is designed to create an unbalanced position while you perform exercises such as calisthenics, medicine ball training, hand weight workouts, and stretching.

Using the Stability Disk will help you develop increased core strength and advanced balancing techniques. Stability Disk training is based on the premise that improving core strength improves limb function and overall performance.

Use the Stability Disk to condition and strengthening your body's central zone or "core," using resistance, recoil, and reaction, the process by which your body moves and learns to move. When you use the Stability Disk to strengthen your core, you will make your other forms of exercise and training more effective, improve your functional conditioning, improve your reactive movement, and encourage "pre-" as opposed to "re-" habilitation by reducing the risk of injury brought on by a weak or deconditioned core.

INFLATING THE STABILITY DISK

The Stability Disk comes inflated. Air can be added to the Stability Disk as needed in the following way:

1. Attach a standard ball inflation needle to your sports pump. Wet the needle, and insert it into the valve in the Stability Disk. Note: A sports pump may be included.
2. Inflate the Stability Disk to the desired firmness. **Do not overinflate the Stability Disk or use an air compressor.**
3. Remove the needle from the valve. The Stability Disk will then be ready for use.

CARING FOR THE STABILITY DISK

Clean the Stability Disk with a damp cloth and mild dishwashing liquid. Then, rinse the Stability Disk with clean water and towel dry it completely.

LIMITED WARRANTY
