



# PROPER FIT INSTRUCTIONS: For proper use, follow these steps each time face mask is worn. 1. Locate the front of the mask (elastic straps are attached to the front of the mask). Be sure the front of the mask is facing out during use. (Fig. 1) 2. Elastic straps should be pre-stretched before placing face mask on the face (Fig. 2). 3. Cup the face mask in your hand, with the face mask cupped in your hand, allowing elastic straps to hang freely (Fig. 3). 4. Align face mask under chin with the nose covering area facing up. 
