High resolution 4K screens are more popular than ever. PaintShop Pro continues to improve its 4K support, so you can work with the latest 4K technology with confidence.


Latest stylus and graphics tablet support

Working with a stylus and tablet can be a game changer for some photographers and designers, opening up new ways to edit and paint. PaintShop Pro 2019 includes support for the latest WinTab stylus and graphics tablets, as well as Windows Ink.

Enjoy a more subtle Autosave. Work with more momentum and less interruptions, thanks to enhancements to the Autosave process. Now you have more control over the frequency of autosaving, and by default, you'll experience less disruptions.

Manage and edit RAW photos taken with some of the latest cameras. Over 100 new cameras are supported in PaintShop Pro 2019.





Simplified with you in mind

All updates have been tailored to users including seamless content migration, more customization capabilities and enhancements to PaintShop Pro's most popular tools.

Seamless content migration

Moving your favorite content, such as plugins, color palettes, gradients, patterns, brushes, and picture tubes, is now available through a simple menu command. This means that any content that you've saved to the default locations, from the last three versions of PaintShop Pro is easily at your fingertips.



Choose File menu > Import > Content from Previous Versions to start the import process.

Conveniently enhance photos from the Crop toolbar

The Crop tool is one of the most popular tools in PaintShop Pro, so in addition to speed improvements, you can now access image enhancement options from the floating Crop toolbar. Apply One Step Photo Fix or one of six Instant Effects (based on our most popular effects). You can also apply a Depth of Field effect to focus on one area of the image and add a gentle blur to other areas.









Using the new Crop toolbar

1. In the **Tools** toolbar, click the **Crop** tool .

The floating Crop toolbar appears below the open image. Note that the enhancement options are turned ON by default (green button displays). By default, One Step Photo Fix is applied.


- 2. To apply an Instant Effect, click the **Instant Effects** button.
- 3. Click and hold the Instant Effects button to choose one of six effect thumbnails.
- 4. To apply Depth of Field, click the **Depth of Field** button.
- 5. Click and hold the **Depth of Field** button to choose an area of focus by clicking a section of the grid, and move the Strength and Size sliders to adjust how much blur is applied and the size of the area that is kept in focus.

Note: You can toggle the enhancement options on and off by clicking the ON/OFF button. The button appears red when the options are turned off.


Customize your user interface text size

With higher screen resolutions, it's nice to know that you can adjust the size of the user interface text to ensure that screen text is readable in a wide variety of situations.

Choose **User Interface** menu > **Text Size**, and choose **Small** or Large. Note that Large text might overlap if used on non-high resolution monitors.









Working with Pic-to-Painting

- 1. In PaintShop Pro, open an image that you want to transform.
- 2. Click Effects > Plugins > Pic-to-Painting.

In the **Pic-to-Painting** window:

Step 1: **Choose a style**; Click the thumbnail for the style that you want to apply.

Step 2: Apply settings; Choose a Strength option.

- 3. Click **Preview** to generate a preview of your image with the selected style applied. You can repeat the process with other styles until you find the look you want.
 - **Step 3**: **Save your painting**; Click **Save and Close**. Your transformed image is added to your PaintShop Pro document as a new layer.







Edit a 360° photo: Remove Tripod

- 1. In PaintShop Pro, open a photo that was captured with a 360° camera. (Sample image available in Documents\Corel PaintShop Pro\2019\Samples. Choose tripod removal.jpg.) When you open a 360° image, a message appears that lets you choose between editing in the 360° Photo window and the Adjust or Effect menu on the Edit tab.
- 2. Click Edit in 360° Photo.
- 3. In the 360° Photo window, click **Remove Tripod**.
- 4. In the Position area, choose **Bottom**.
- 5. Click the Freehand Selection tool.
- 6. Drag around the tripod. You don't have to be very precise, you can include some surrounding area in the selection.
 - 7. Set the Feather to 10.
 - 8. Click **Magic Fill.** If you need to fine-tune, you can repeat the selection and Magic Fill steps.
 - 9. Click **Save As**, and save your file to a new file name and choose the original file format.







Convert a 360° photo to a tiny planet image

- 1. In PaintShop Pro, open a photo that was captured with a 360° camera. (Sample image available in ...Documents\Corel PaintShop Pro\2019\Samples. Choose Landscape-3.jpg.) A message appears that lets you choose between editing in the 360° Photo window and the Adjust or Effect menu on the Edit tab.
- 2. Click Edit in 360° Photo.
- 3. In the 360° Photo window, click Planet Effects.
- 4. Click the **Tiny planet** option to create a planet-like effect, adjust the sliders on the right to rotate or change the field of view.
- 5. Click **Save As**, and save the image to a new name.

Important: Planet Effects and the **360° to Panorama** effect remove 360° metadata from files. To protect the original file, ensure that you save to a new file name.


