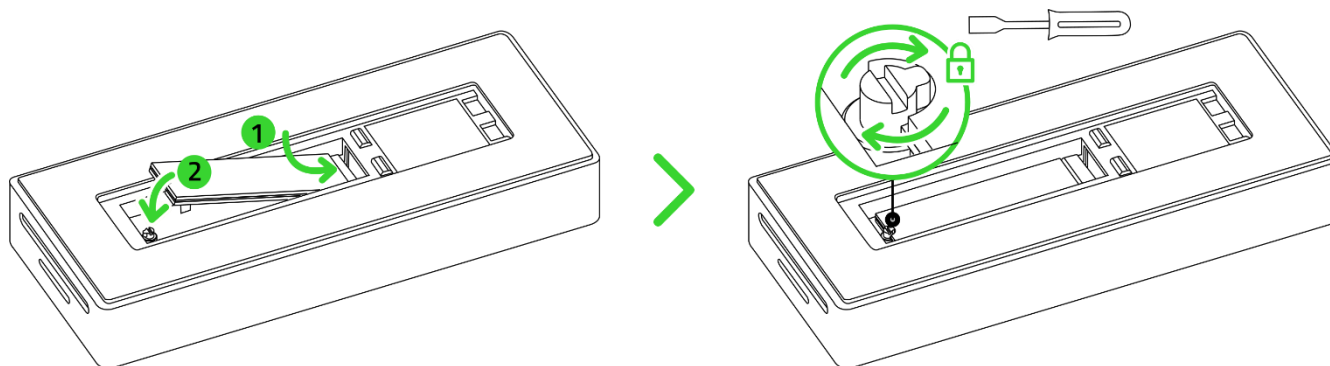
(OPTIONAL) INSTALLING AN NVMe M.2 SSD

5. SAFETY AND MAINTENANCE

SAFETY GUIDELINES

To achieve maximum safety while using your Razer Thunderbolt™ 5 Dock, we suggest that you adopt the following guidelines:

Should you have trouble operating the device properly and troubleshooting doesn't work, unplug the device and contact the Razer hotline or go to support.razer.com for assistance.

Before installing an M.2 SSD, make sure that the dock is unplugged from the power outlet and disconnected from your computer to prevent electric shocks.

Always use quality Thunderbolt-certified cables. Non-standard cables may not provide adequate power delivery or data transfer rates and may affect the dock's performance and safety.

When disconnecting a device, avoid tugging on its cable wire abruptly. Gently unplug your device from its connector.

Don't take apart the device, and don't attempt to operate it under abnormal current loads. Doing so will void your warranty.

Keep the device away from liquid, humidity or moisture. Operate the device only within the specific temperature range of 0°C (32°F) to 40°C (104°F). Should the temperature exceed this range, unplug and/or switch off the device in order to let the temperature stabilize to an optimal level.

MAINTENANCE

The Razer Thunderbolt™ 5 Dock requires minimum maintenance to keep it in optimum condition. Once a month, we recommend that you unplug the device from the computer and clean it using a soft cloth or cotton swab to prevent dirt buildup. Don't use soap or harsh cleaning agents.
