Caution: All cards must be inserted into the card reader label side up. Failure to do so could result in damage to the memory card or the card reader. Do not force a memory card into the card reader.

CONNECTING THE CARD READER

Plug one end of a USB cable into the USB port of the card reader and the other end into an available USB port on your computer. Your computer loads the drivers automatically.

USING THE CARD READER

Cautions:

- Insert a card, label side up, into the appropriate slot. Failure to do so may result in damage to your card and/or card reader.
- Do not remove memory cards while the blue or green data LED on the reader is flashing. Doing so may lead to loss of data or damage to your memory card.
- This card reader will support inserting both microSD, SD, and CompactFlash cards at the same time.

The blue LED lights when you connect the card reader to a USB port on your computer. It also lights when you insert a memory card and blinks when data is being read or written.

To access a memory card using Windows:

- 1 Insert a card, label side up, into the appropriate slot. The data LED lights.
- 2 Click **Start**, then click *My Computer/Computer*. Double-click the drive letter to see its contents.
- 3 Use normal Windows procedures to open, copy, paste, and delete files.
- 4 Right-click the name of your card and select **Eject** when you are finished.
- 5 Do not remove your card from the card reader until the data LED stops blinking and the name of your card disappears from the window.

To access a memory card using Mac OS 9.0 or higher:

- 1 Insert a card, label side up, into the appropriate slot. The data LED lights.
- 2 Open the **Finder** window, then click your card's name in the left menu to view its contents.
- 3 Use normal Mac procedures to open, copy, paste, and delete files.
- 4 Right-click the name of your card and select **Eject** when you are finished.

- 5 Do not remove your card from the card reader until the data LED stops blinking and the name of your card disappears from the Finder window.
