

1 START HERE

How do I attach the stand to my TV? (not for wall mounting)
You'll need: A Phillips screwdriver and a soft surface to lay the TV on.

- **A** Secure the TV stand to the stand column with one of the provided screws.
- **B** Carefully place your TV face-down on a cushioned, clean surface to protect the screen from damages and scratches, then insert the stand column.
- **C** Secure the stand column to the TV with two of the provided screws.







How do I prepare my TV for wall mounting?

(not for use with a TV stand)

- **A** Carefully place your TV screen face-down on a cushioned, clean surface to protect the screen from damages and scratches.
- **B** Locate the mounting screw holes on the back of your TV. See the instructions that came with your wall mount for more information about how to correctly mount your TV.


Your TV has several different jacks for connecting devices. For the best video quality, use the best available connection. Use the cables that came with your devices.








Multi-purpose ports: You can plug any device that uses HDMI into either HDMI jack. However, an ARC or DVI device must be connected to the HDMI 1/ARC/DVI jack. See the instructions that came with your ARC or DVI device for more information.

Note: The **HDMI 1/ARC/DVI** jack is a shared jack. This mean you can connect either an ARC device or a DVI device.






