


## **DX-WRM1401 Wired USB Mouse**

- One available USB port


### **Setting up your mouse**

Function	Description
Left button	For left clicking
Wheel	For scrolling
Right button	For right clicking

**Tip:** Avoid using your mouse on reflective, transparent, or metallic surfaces.

- Only use the mouse on a clean, flat, non-slippery surface to ensure smooth and accurate cursor action.
