
**B** - Upper bracket (2)

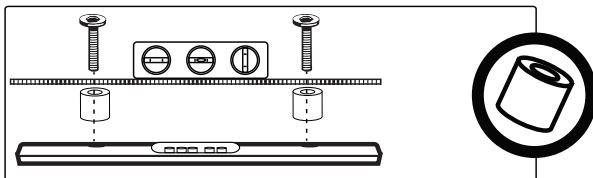
## Assembling your replacement feet

### STEP 1: Determining whether your TV has a flat back or an irregular or obstructed back

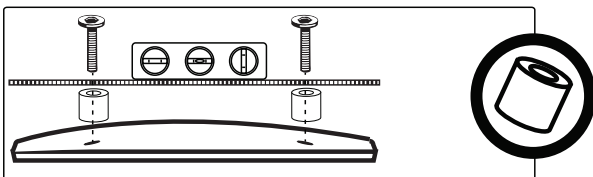
- 1 Carefully place your TV screen face-down on a cushioned, clean surface to protect the screen from damages and scratches.
- 2 If your TV has a table-top stand attached, remove the stand. See the documentation that came with your TV for instructions.
- 3 Lay the TV brackets, oriented vertically, on the back of your TV.
- 4 Align the screw holes in the TV brackets with the mounting screw holes on your TV.
- 5 Identify which type of back your TV has:
  - **Flat back:** The brackets lay flush against the back of your TV and do not block any jacks. You do not need spacers when assembling the wall mount.



- **Obstructed back:** The brackets block one or more of the jacks on the back of your TV. You will need spacers when assembling the wall mount.



- **Irregularly-shaped back:** There is a gap between a bracket and some part of the back of your TV. You will need spacers when assembling the wall mount.



- 6 Remove the TV brackets.

## STEP 2: Selecting screws, washers, and spacers

- 1 Select the hardware for your TV (screws, washers, and spacers). A limited number of TVs come with mounting hardware included (if there are screws that came your TV, they are almost always in the holes on the back of your TV). If you do not know the correct length of the mounting screws your TV requires, test various sizes by hand-threading the screws.

### For a TV with a flat back:

M4 X 12 mm screws (**M**)

M6 X 12 mm screws (**N**)

M6 X 20 mm screws (**O**)

M8 X 20 mm screws (**P**)

### For a TV with an irregular/obstructed back:

M4 X 35 mm screws (**Q**)

M6 X 35 mm screws (**R**)

M8 X 35 mm screws (**S**)

M8 X 50 mm screws (**T**)

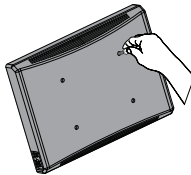
Select either an M4/M5 washer (**Y**) or an M6 washer (**Z**) for the corresponding types of screws. For an irregular or obstructed TV back, also use the spacers (**U**, **V**, **W**, or **X**).

**Note:** If the included hardware does not work for your TV, call 1-877-467-4289, for Insignia Customer Support, and we will work to determine the necessary parts required and ship them to you without charge.

**CAUTION:** To avoid potential personal injuries and property damage, make sure that there are adequate threads to secure the brackets to your TV. If you encounter resistance, stop immediately and contact customer service. Use the shortest screw and spacer combination to accommodate your TV. Using hardware that is too long may damage your TV. However, using a screw that is too short may cause your TV to fall from the mount.

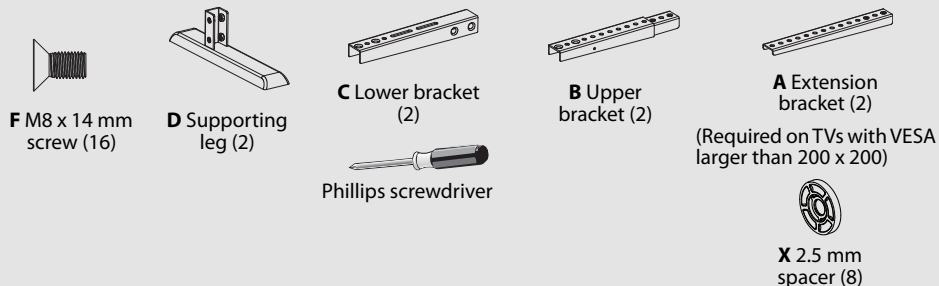

- 2 Remove the screws from the holes in the back of your TV.

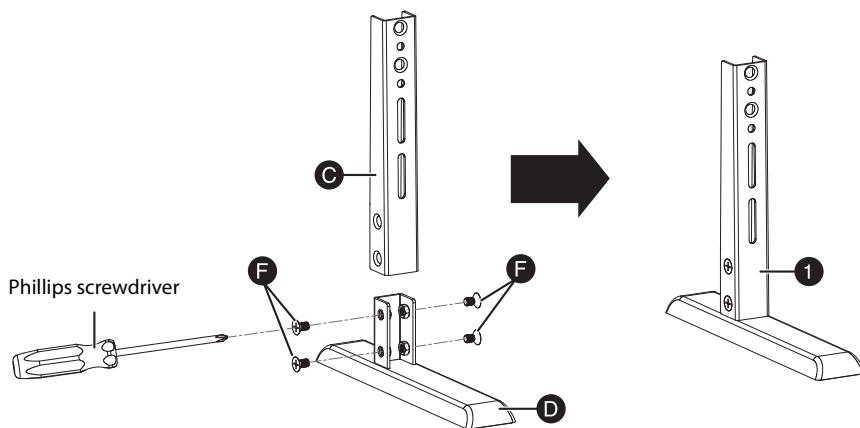
## STEP 3: Assembling the TV feet

### You will need:

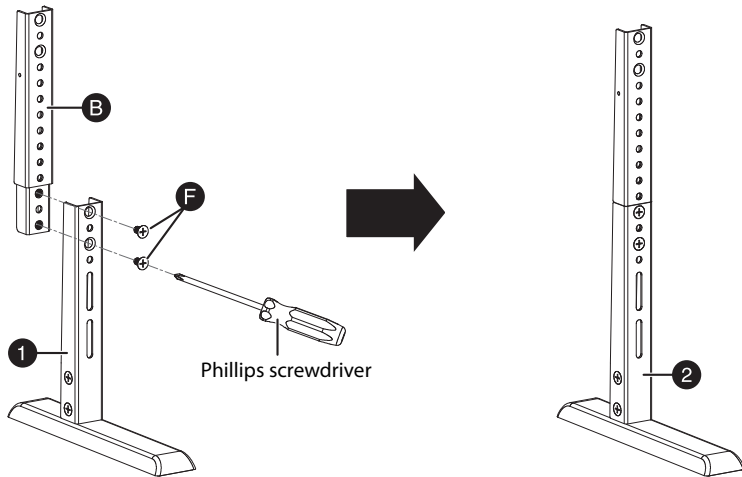


- 1 Using a Phillips screwdriver, attach the supporting leg (**D**) to the lower bracket (**C**) with four M8 x 14 mm screws (**F**), completing bracket assembly (**1**).

**Important:** Make sure that the lower brackets (**C**) face the correct direction (front to back), as shown below.



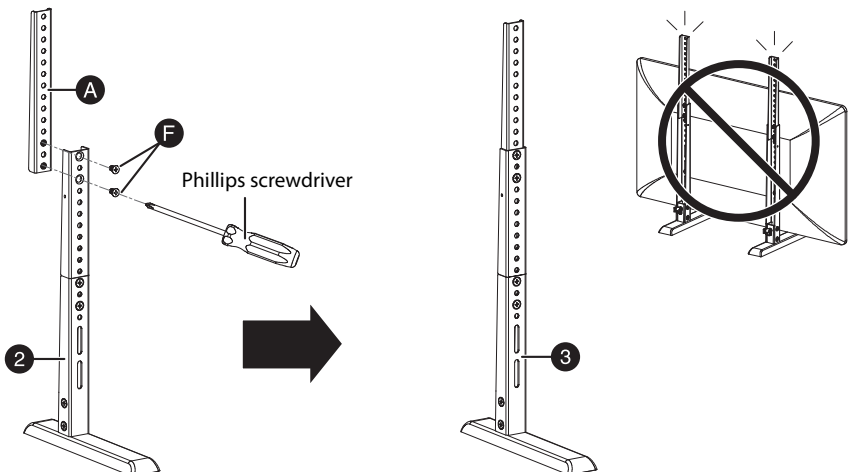
- 2 Using a Phillips screwdriver, attach the upper bracket (B) to the bracket assembly 1 with two M8 x 14 mm screws (F), completing bracket assembly (2).



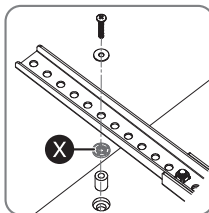
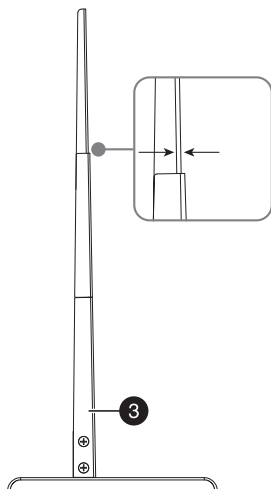
- 3 Tighten the screws with a screwdriver until they are snug against the TV brackets. Do not over tighten.
- 4 Repeat for the other TV bracket.

**Note:** It may be necessary to add extensions (A) to the bracket assembly (2) if the bracket assemblies are too short for your TV (VESA larger than 200 x 200 mm) with only the lower and upper brackets in place. If you determine that this is necessary, proceed with step 5 below.

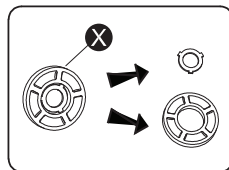
- 5 Optional - Using a Phillips screwdriver, attach the extension bracket (A) to the bracket assembly (2) with two M8 x 14 mm screws (F).



- 6 Add 2.5 mm spacers (X) to the top attachment screws to make up for the difference in bracket thickness between the lower bracket (C) and the extension bracket (A).



**CAUTION:** Do not use an electric drill



**Tip:** If you need to combine an M6 or M8 screw with a 2.5 mm spacer (X), you must remove the inner circle from the spacer.

- 7 Using a Phillips screwdriver, tighten the screws until they are snug against the TV feet. Do not over tighten.
  - 8 For a flat back TV, go to "STEP 4: Option 1 - Attaching brackets to a TV with a flat back" on page 11.
- OR-
- For an irregular or obstructed back, go to "STEP 4: Option 2 - Attaching brackets to a TV with an irregular or obstructed back" on page 12.

## STEP 4: Option 1 - Attaching brackets to a TV with a flat back

### You will need:

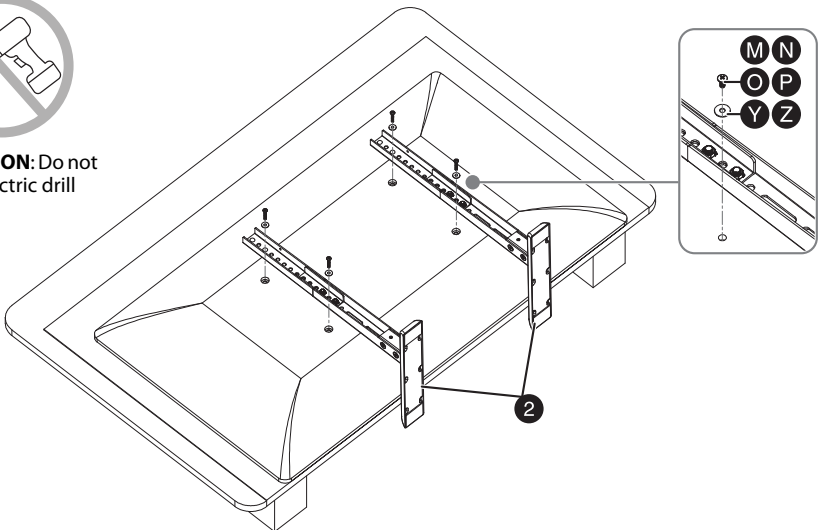

- 1 Align the left and right TV feet (2) with the screw holes on the back of the TV. Make sure that the brackets are level.
- 2 Place washers (**Y** or **Z**) over the holes in the TV stands. Insert screws (**M**, **N**, **O**, or **P**) through the washers and TV feet.

**Note:** No washers are required if you use the M8 x 20 mm screws (**P**).

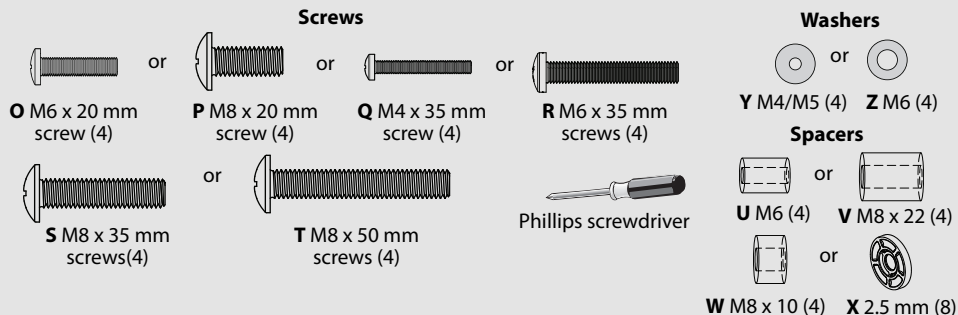

## STEP 4: Option 2 - Attaching brackets to a TV with an irregular or obstructed back

### You will need:

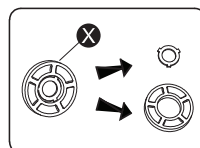
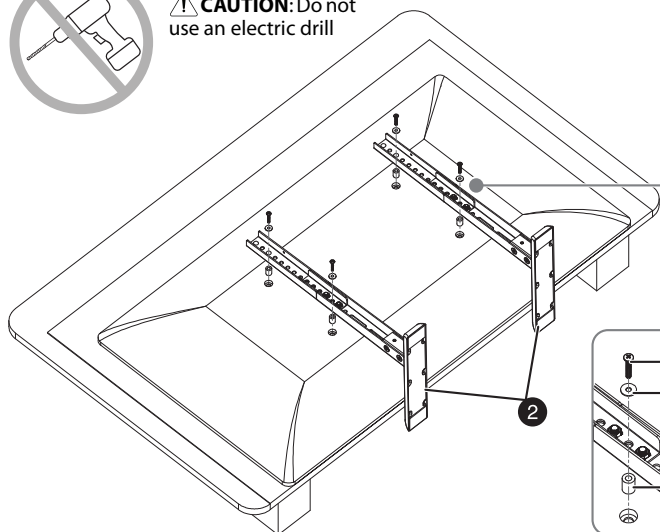


- 1 Place spacers (**U**, **V**, **W**, or **X**) over the holes on the back of the TV.
- 2 Align the left and right TV feet (2) with the screw holes on the back of the TV. Make sure that the brackets are level.
- 3 Place washers (**Y** or **Z**) over the holes in the TV feet (except for M8 screws **O**, **P**, **S**, or **T**). Insert screws (**O**, **P**, **Q**, **R**, **S**, or **T**) through the washers, TV brackets, and spacers.

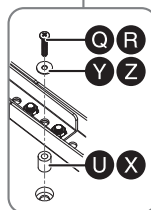
**Note:** No washers are required if you use the M8 screws (**O**, **P**, **S**, or **T**).



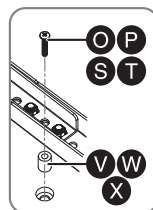
**CAUTION:** Do not use an electric drill



**Tip:** If you need to combine an M6 or M8 screw with a 2.5 mm spacer (**X**), you must remove the inner circle from the spacer.

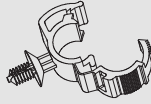


- 4 Using a Phillips screwdriver, tighten the screws until they are snug against the TV stands. Do not over tighten.



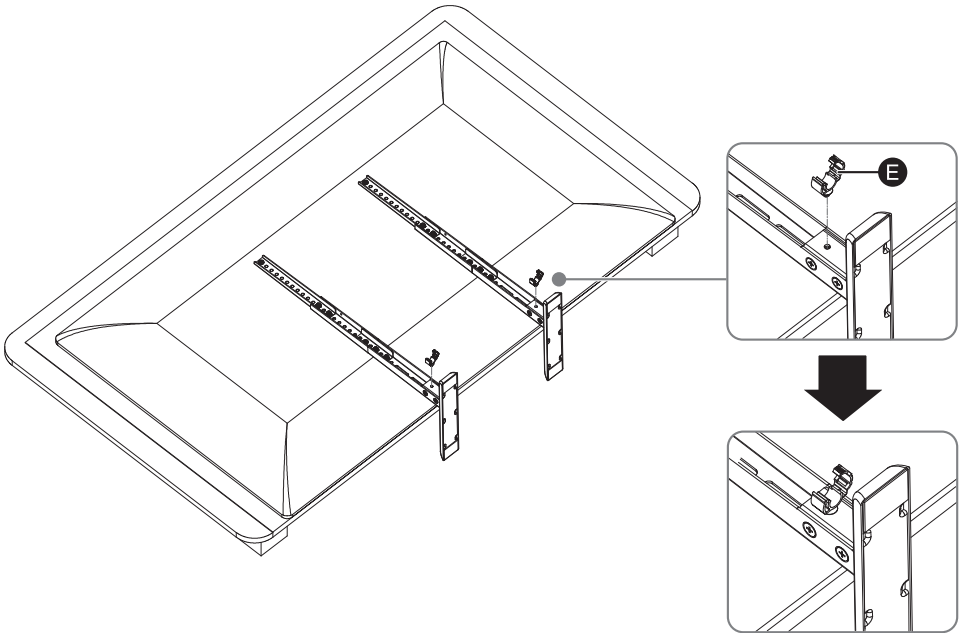
## STEP 5 - Attaching the cable clips and securing the cables

### You will need

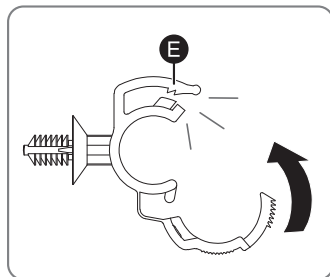
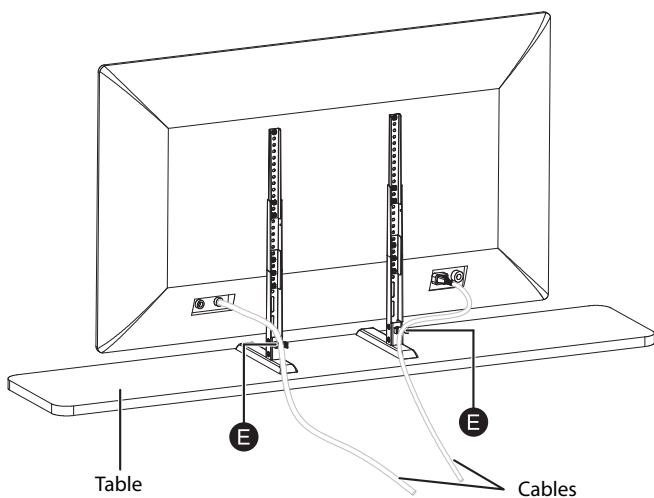


E - Cable clip (2)

- 1 Put a cable clip (E) into the hole in each of the lower backs of the TV feet (as shown below).



- 2 Insert the power cord and video cable into the cable clips, then fasten the cable clips (E).



## STEP 6 - Installing the anti-tip safety strap

The safety belt (G) can be attached to a table top (Option 1), if the table is made of wood and you don't mind installing screws into the wood. It can also be attached to a wall (Option 2) behind your TV.

### Option 1 - Table-top installation:

#### You will need:



G Safety belt (2)



K M4 x 12 mm self-tapping screws (2)



L M4 washer (2)



I M5 x 8 mm screw (2)

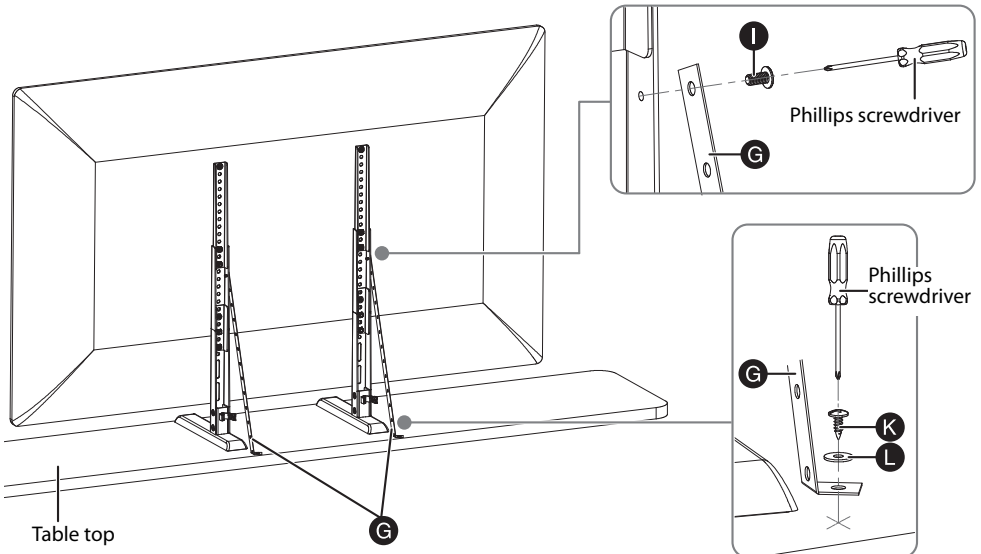

**CAUTION:** Serious damage may result if your TV tips forward and falls from a table. To avoid this, we recommend installing the safety belt (G) to stabilize your TV.

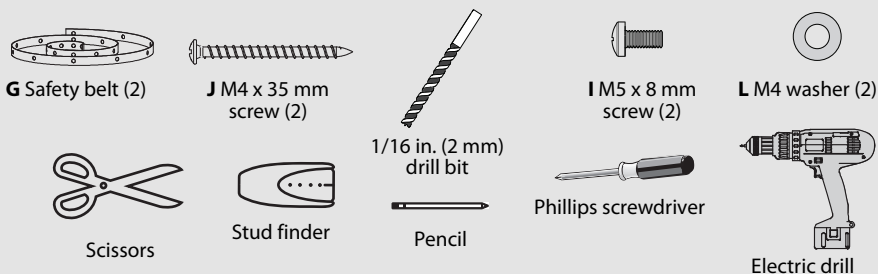
**Note:** This installation is suitable for wooden tables that are at least 0.6 in. (15 mm) thick. Before installing the Anti-tip safety strap, make sure that the table's strength can support it.

- 1 Using scissors, cut the safety belt (G) into lengths suitable to go from the table top to the installation holes on your TV feet. If the safety belt (G) obstructs the chassis, you can cut off the excess length with scissors.
- 2 Using a Phillips screwdriver, connect the safety belt lengths (G) to the table top with M4 x 12 mm self-tapping screws (K) and M4 washers (L) directly behind the TV feet.
- 3 Using a Phillips screwdriver, connect the other ends of the safety belt (G) to the mounting holes in the TV feet with M5 x 8 mm screws (I).



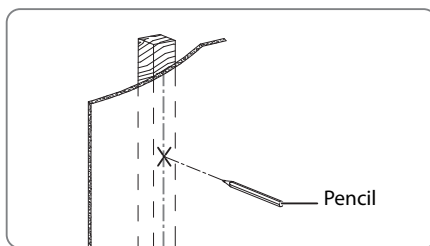
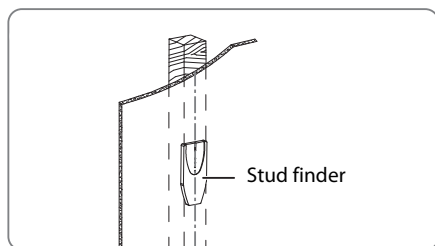
## Option 2 - Wallboard installation:

### You will need:

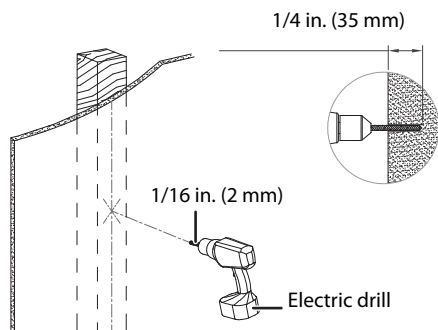


**⚠ CAUTION:** Nominal wood stud size is 2 x 4 in. and the wallboard thickness should be no more than 5/8 in. thick. If the wall isn't strong enough to hold up your TV, it could still tip over and be damaged.

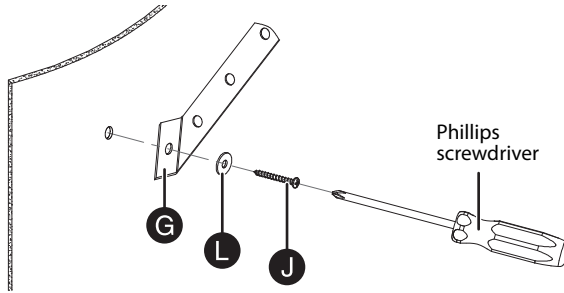
- 1 Using scissors, cut the safety belt (**G**) into lengths suitable to go from the wall to the installation holes on your TV feet.
- 2 Using a stud finder, determine the middle of the studs in the wall you will be using, corresponding to the locations of the installation holes in the TV feet, then mark the spots with a pencil.



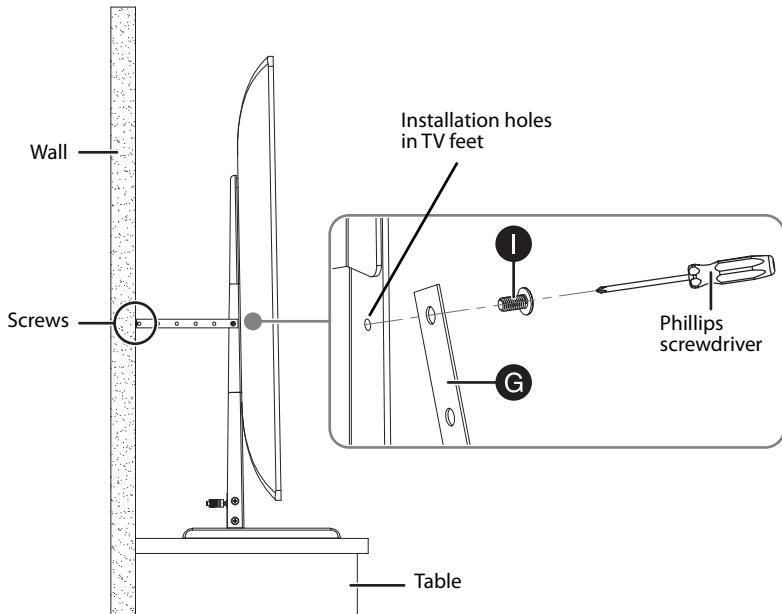
- 3 Using an electric drill and a 1/16 in. (2 mm) drill bit, drill two 1/4 in. (35 mm) holes where indicated by the pencil marks.



- 4** Using a Phillips screwdriver, connect the safety belt lengths (**G**) to the wall with M4 x 35 mm self-tapping screws (**J**) and M4 washers (**L**).

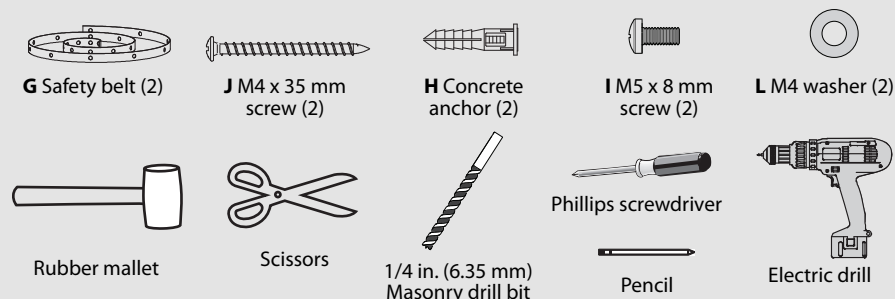


- 5** Connect the other ends of the safety belt lengths (**G**) to the mounting holes in the TV feet with M5 x 8 mm screws (**I**).



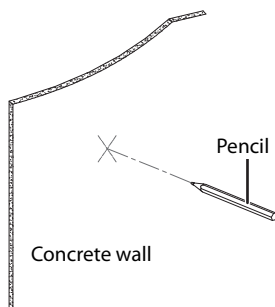
## Option 3 - Installing on a solid concrete or concrete block wall:

### You will need:

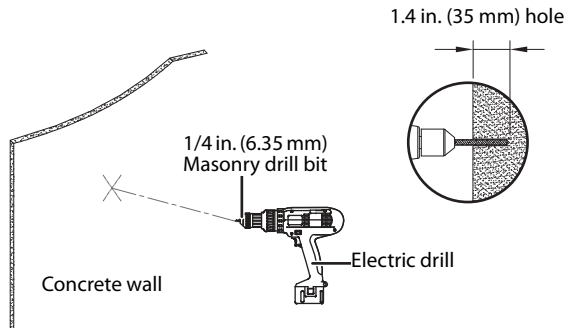


**⚠ CAUTION:** Determine the strength of the wall you intend to use to prevent your TV from tipping. If the wall isn't strong enough to hold up your TV, it could still tip over and be damaged.

- 1 Using scissors, cut the safety belt (**G**) into lengths suitable to go from the wall to the installation holes on your TV feet.
- 2 Using a pencil, mark the wall in two places that correspond to the locations of the installation holes in the TV feet.

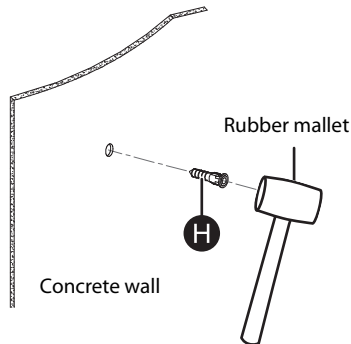
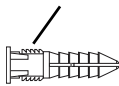


- 3 Using an electric drill and a 1/4 in. (6.35 mm) masonry drill bit, drill two 1.4 in. (35 mm) holes where indicated by the pencil marks.

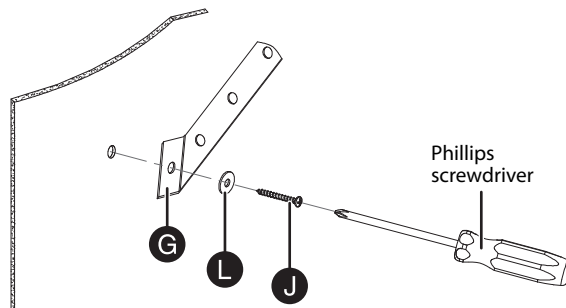


- 4 Using a rubber mallet, gently tap the concrete anchors (H) into both holes until flush with the wall.

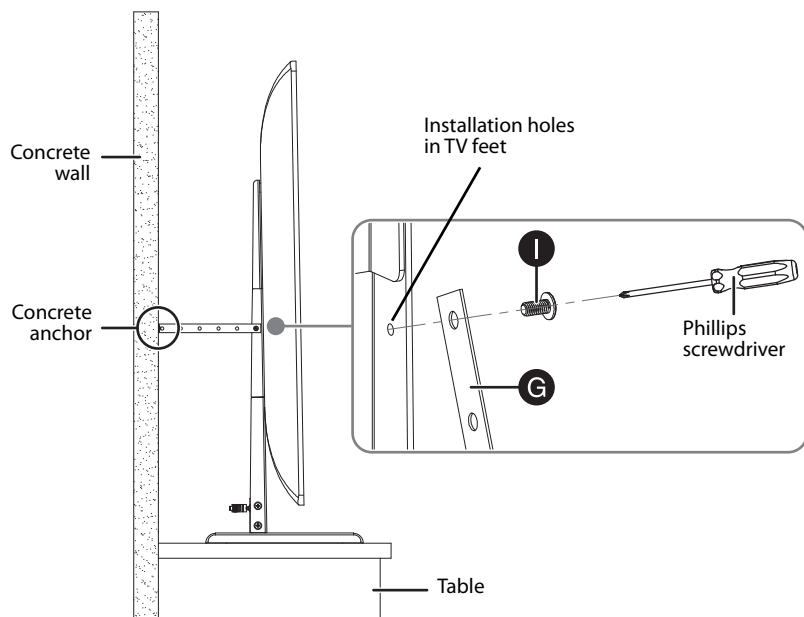
**Note:** If you have trouble inserting the anchor in the hole, squeeze the indicated portion of the anchor.



- 5 Using a Phillips screwdriver, connect the safety belt lengths (G) to the concrete anchors (H) in the wall with M4 x 35 mm self-tapping screws (J) and M4 washers (L).



- 6 Connect the other ends of the safety belt lengths (**G**) to the mounting holes in the TV feet with M5 x 8 mm screws (**I**).

## What does this warranty cover?

During the Warranty Period, if the original manufacture of the material or workmanship of the Product is determined to be defective by an authorized Insignia repair center or store personnel, Insignia will (at its sole option): (1) repair the Product with new or rebuilt parts; or (2) replace the Product at no charge with new or rebuilt comparable products or parts. Products and parts replaced under this warranty become the property of Insignia and are not returned to you. If service of Products or parts are required after the Warranty Period expires, you must pay all labor and parts charges. This warranty lasts as long as you own your Insignia Product during the Warranty Period. Warranty coverage terminates if you sell or otherwise transfer the Product.

## How to obtain warranty service?

## Where is the warranty valid?
