





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WIRING & ANTENNA CONNECTIONS

RGB Extension Cable: Pioneer part # CD-RGB150E (not sold by Metra)


TOOLS REQUIRED

- Panel removal tool • Phillips screwdriver


Attention! Let the vehicle sit with the key out of the ignition for a few minutes before removing the factory radio. When testing the aftermarket equipment, ensure that all factory equipment is connected before cycling the key to ignition.

DASH DISASSEMBLY


1. Unclip and remove the panel below the steering column. (Figure A)
2. Unclip the climate control panel and set aside. (Figure B)
3. Remove (2) Phillips screws securing the radio trim panel, then unclip and remove the panel. (Figure C)
4. Remove (4) Phillips screws securing the radio, then unplug and remove.




KIT ASSEMBLY

ISO DDIN radio provision

1. Secure the **radio brackets** to the radio using screws supplied with the radio. (Figure A)
2. Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna connector in the dash and complete all necessary connections to the radio. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra and/or Axxess. Test the radio for proper operation.
3. Place the radio into the dash, then secure using the factory screws.
4. Attach (4) **panel clips** provided onto the **radio bezel**, then attach the bezel over the radio. (Figure B)
5. Reassemble the dash in reverse order of disassembly to complete the installation.


KIT ASSEMBLY

Pioneer Modular DDIN radio provision

1. Secure the radio display to the **Pioneer adapter brackets** using (6) screws supplied with the radio. (Figure A)


Note: Reference the installation manual provided with the radio for which hardware to use. The display screen and radio chassis use two different types of screws.

2. Find a suitable location for the radio chassis. Route the RGB extension cable from the radio chassis to the display screen, then connect it to the display screen.

3. Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna connector in the dash and complete all necessary connections to the radio. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra and/or Axxess. Test the radio for proper operation.
4. Place the radio display into to the dash, then secure using the factory screws.
5. Attach (4) **panel clips** provided onto the **radio bezel**, then attach the bezel over the radio. (Figure B)
6. Reassemble the dash in reverse order of disassembly to complete the installation.
