Removed the clock battery pull tab

Before using the clock, pull out the plastic Battery Tab located on bottom panel.

Useing the clock

Set time and date

- 1 Normal display when electrified. Press "SET" to activate setting of time and date. Complete setting through Pressing UP/DOWN. The sequence is as follows: hour->minute->year-> month-> day-> week->exit.
- 2 The range of setting: 1-12 or 0-23 for hour, 0-59 for minute, .2000-2099 for year, 1-12 for month,1-31 for day, Week will change from MON to SUN automatically with changes of date.
- 3 Exit and display time set currently when AL key pressed for 1 minute on setting condition.
- 4 Convert between 12-hour and 24-hour on normal condition

Setting of alarm clock and snooze

- 1 Press AL once into alarm mode on normal condition
- 2 Press SET to activate setting of alarm clock on alarm condition. Complete setting through pressing UP/DOWN .The sequence is as follow:.hour- > minute -> snooze -> exit
- 3 Exit and display time set currently when MODE key pressed or not any key pressed for 1 minute on setting Condition
- 4 One minute alarm last when time set is up; alarm bell ring when snooze time is up. Press SET to cancel ringing or press any key to stop ringing.
- 5 When alarm and snooze flag is not activated, that is to say both alarm clock and snooze are closed, only when Alarm is activated, press UP snooze is valid.


Temperature conversion:

- 2 Install 3 "AAA" size batteries into the compartment, making sure that the + and polarities match the diagram printed inside.
- **3** Close the battery compartment door and tighten the battery door screw. Don't over tighten.

Replacing the clock backup batteries

Uses 2 x LR44 (included) for backup to provide continuous alarm operation and clock settings. Replaced the clock battery, repeat the step 1 & 3. Install 2 x "LR44" size batteries into the compartment, making sure that the + and - polarities match the diagram printed inside.

For the Best Possible Performance

- Only use the recommended/supplied batteries or equivalent.
- Use alkaline batteries for longer life.
- Do not mix old and new batteries, and do not mix alkaline, carbon-zinc or rechargeable nickel-cadmium batteries.
