CHOOSING THE PROPER LOCATION

ELECTRICITY

Use an individual, grounded outlet:115 Volts, 60 Hz, AC, 15 Amps minimum.



WARNING

- Do not overload house wiring and cause a fire hazard by plugging in multiple appliances in the same outlet with the refrigerator.
- To reduce the risk of electric shock, do not install the refrigerator in a wet or damp area.

FLOORING

To avoid noise and vibration, the unit must be installed and leveled on a solidly constructed floor. If required, adjust the leveling legs to compensate for the unevenness of the floor.

NOTE


 Installing on carpeting, soft tile surfaces, a platform or weakly supported structure is not recommended.

AMBIENT TEMPERATURE

- Install this appliance in an area where the temperature is between 50° F (10° C) and 95°F (35°C)
- If the temperature around the appliance is too low or high, cooling ability may be adversely affected.

PRODUCT DIMENSIONS


- Check the dimensions of the appliance and the installation path to ensure there is sufficient room to move the refrigerator through doors or narrow
- The installation location chosen for the refrigerator should allow space behind the unit for connections and airflow and space in front to open the doors.
- Too small of a distance from adjacent items may result in lowered freezing capability and increased electricity consumption charges.



LEVELING

The refrigerator has two front leveling legs. Adjust the legs to alter the tilt from front-to back or side-to-side. If the refrigerator seems unsteady, or the door does not close easily, adjust the refrigerator's tilt using the instructions

- Open the bottom drawer and remove the cover from the appliance.
- Turn the leveling leg to the left to raise that side of the refrigerator or to the right to lower it. It may take several turns of the leveling leg to adjust the tilt of the refrigerator.
- Open the door and the drawers and check to make sure that they close easily. If they do not close easily, tilt the refrigerator slightly more to the rear by turning both leveling legs to the left. It may take several more turns, and be sure to turn both leveling legs the same amount.
- When the refrigerator is level, open the bottom drawer and reassemble the cover.



TURNING ON THE POWER

After installing, plug the refrigerator's power cord into a 3-prong grounded outlet and push the refrigerator into the final position.

A CAUTION

- Connect to a rated power outlet.
- Have a certified electrician check the wall outlet and wiring for proper grounding.
- Do not damage or cut off the ground terminal of the power plug.
