


TOOLS REQUIRED

• Panel removal tool • Phillips screwdriver


Attention! Let the vehicle sit with the key out of the ignition for a few minutes before removing the factory radio. When testing the aftermarket equipment, ensure that all factory equipment is connected before cycling the key to ignition.

DASH DISASSEMBLY

- 1. Unclip the driver's side panel to the right of the steering column. The panel only needs unclipped enough to remove the dash panel in the following steps. (Figure A)
- 2. Open the passenger door, then unclip and remove the panel on the side of the dash. Remove (1) Phillips screw exposed. (Figure B)







- **3.** Open the glove box, then unclip and remove the glove box. (Figure C)
- **4.** Remove (9) Phillips screws in the glove box cavity, then remove the glove box housing. (Figure D)




DASH DISASSEMBLY (CONT.)

- 5. Remove (1) Phillips screw securing the passenger side a/c vent, then remove the vent. (Figure E)
- **6.** Remove (1) Phillips screw securing the dash panel above the glovebox, then unclip and remove the panel. (Figure F)
- Remove (4) Phillips screw securing the radio. Slide the radio out then unclip and remove the radio. (Figure G)





KIT ASSEMBLY

- Secure the radio brackets to the radio using the screws supplied with the radio. (Figure A)
- Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna connector in the dash and complete all necessary connections to the radio. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra and/or Axxess. Test the radio for proper operation.
- **3.** Secure the radio assembly to the dash using the factory screws.
- **4.** Clip the radio trim panel to the dash.
- **5.** Reassemble the dash in reverse order of disassembly to complete the installation.
