- Do not use chair unless all bolts and screws are firmly secured and fastened.
- Check all bolts and screws every 90 days. As necessary tighten if any are loose.
- Pushing over or dragging this chair can result in an injury or cause damage to some floor types and the chair itself. To move this chair lift and then move it.
- Do not let children play in or around the chair due to the possible risk of injury.

PRE ASSEMBLY

- · Clear a space for the assembly of the chair.
- Lay out all parts on the Parts List. A clear space will allow you to easily determine if all the pieces are available.
- Save all packing materials until assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding smaller parts or hardware.
- Keep small parts and pieces away from children and pets.
- Please check the chair for any loose screws and tighten them before use.




Select a flat and non-abrasive surface to avoid scratching the parts. Insert Casters (A) into the Star Base (B) Turn the Star Base (B) over and insert the Gas Lift with Telescopic Cover (C) through the center hole on top of Star Base (B).





Fasten the Arms (E1&E2) onto sides of the Seat Cushion (F) by using Small Screws (J) with Allen Key (L).

*Note: Do not tighten the screws completely at this stage of the assembly.








Place the Back Cushion (G) flat between Arms (E1&E2) and use Small Screws (J) on lower screw holes to attach both Arms (E1 &E2) and Back Cushion (G) with Allen Key (L).

*Note: Do not tighten the screws completely at this stage of the assembly.








Push the Back Cushion (G) up to a vertical position and attach the Arms (E1&E2) by using Small Screws (J) with the Allen Key (L).

*Note: Align the arms and cushions and tighten all the screws completely.








Attach Seat Plate (D) to the bottom of the Seat Cushion (F) by using Large Long Screws (I) for the front holes of the Seat Plate (D) and Large Screws (H) for the rear holes of the Seat Plate (D) with Allen Key (L).

*Note: Align the Seat Plate so the label "FRONT" on the seat plate aligns with the label "FRONT" on the bottom of the seat cushion.


Tighten the screws completely.








Place the assembled Seat Cushion (F) with Seat Plate (D) on top of the Gas Lift (C) and press down until fully engaged.





Place the Black Plastic Caps (K) into arm holes once screws have been completely tightened. The chair is now ready for use.



Product Features & Instructions Seat Height Adjustment




The seat height adjuster allows optimal height and posture to be achieved to relieve stresses on the lower back, legs and thighs.

• To Raise The Seat

Lean forward slightly to relieve pressure on the tilt mechanism. Reach under the right side of the chair to locate the height adjustment handle and lift the handle and allow the chair to rise to the desired height.

• To Lower The Seat

Remain fully seated, lift the handle upward, and allow the chair to descend. Descent will stop once handle is released or the chair reaches its bottom position.



Product Features & Instructions Upright Seat Tilt Lock




The locking mechanism fixes the Chair upright or allows the chair to rock back and forth.

Allow Tilt

While seated, reach under the right side of the chair to locate the height adjustment handle Pull the handle all the way out (away from the seat plate) to allow the chair to tilt back and forth.

Lock Upright

Sit fully upright and push the handle in towards the seat plate to lock upright.



Product Features & Instructions Tilt Tension




The tensioner increases or decreases the amount of force needed to recline the chair backward or to rock the chair

• Firmer / Stiffer - Clockwise (L)

Reach under the front center of the chair and locate the round Tensioner knob. Turn the knob clockwise to make the chair recline firmer / stifler.

• Softer / Looser - Counter Clockwise (R)

Turn the knob counter-clockwise to make the chair recline softer / looser.





Limited Warranty



The manufacturers products are warrantied against defects in material and workmanship while owned by the "Original Purchaser". The term "Original Purchaser" is defined as the party or entity which purchases this manufacturer's furniture from an authorized retailer as shown by the original sales receipt.
