# Charging



## The charging case fails to charge via a charging cable.

Check the charging cable and adapter.

Make sure the charging cable and adapter is plugged in correctly.

Check the LED indicator.

During charging, the LED will breath and indicate the current battery status.



#### The hearing aids fails to charge.

Check the charging case's battery.

Make sure the charging case is charged, when you open the lid of charging case, the LED will turn on.

 Make sure the hearing aids are put properly in the charging case.

Make sure they are put in place and the charging contact is connected.

Make sure the pogo-pin is not covered.

The hearing aids are charged through the pogo-pin, make sure they are not covered.



# Sound



## Whistling/squealing sound after putting on hearing aids.

- The sound from the speaker can be re-amplified by the microphone, resulting in whistling/squealing sound, it is normal to occur in the below situations.
- 1. Hearing aids are not worn properly.
- 2. High volume / too much treble.
- 3. Hands near the hearing aid.
- 4. Answering the phone.
- If you experience whistling/squealing issue, you may consider below solutions.
- 1. Wear the hearing aids properly in your ear. Make sure the hearing aids are sealed after you wear them.
- 2. Choose a suitable dome.

Make sure the hearing aids are fully inserted in your ear.

3. Adjust the volume or tone.

Try lower the volume or reduce treble.



## Sound is too loud.

Check the volume control.

You can start with low volume, then increase the volume gradually until you feel comfortable.

Adjust the tone.

You can fine tune with the tone adjustment feature in the app.



Check the remaining power of your hearing aids.

Make sure your hearing aids are charged;

 Check the microphone, earpiece are free from earwax.

The microphone/earpiece might be blocked by earwax, you may clean with a clean cloth or cotton swab.



#### Too much noise.

Switch the mode.

You can switch to different modes by holding and pressing the volume button:

Noise reduction mode (beep x1). Dialogue mode (beep x2). Feedback suppression mode (beep x3).

Lower the volume.

Press the volume down button.



## Sound is too tiny.

Check the volume control.

You can increase the volume in your hearing aids or the app.

 Check the microphone, earpiece are free from earwax.

The microphone/earpiece might be blocked by earwax, you may clean with a clean cloth or cotton swab.

 Wear hearing aids properly and choose a suitable dome.

Make sure hearing aids are fully inserted in your ear canal.



## Sound is distorted.

Check the tone setting.

You can tune the tone in the app to match your hearing situation.

Get used to your hearing aids.

If this is your first experience with hearing aids, it is suggested to follow our 4P instructions and get used to your hearing aids in a month period.

• Hearing aids effective voice pick-up range

The effecive voice pick-up range usually 10ft, if you need to hear sound from a distance, you can use LINNER Connect.

## **Omfort and stability.**

• Choose suitable ear tips and ear fins.

LINNER Mars provides 7 sizes ear tips and 4 sizes ear fins, choose a suitable combination that can provide better comfort and stability.

Wear properly.

Wear hearing aids as shown above, make sure the hearing aids fit the shape of your ear.

Ergonomics.
