Unpacking the boxes





There are seven unique box types

Depending on your configuration, you'll almost definitely have multiple boxes, and may not have all seven different boxes. That's okay! For now, you should just group each box type together (Inline Seat boxes in one spot, Corner Seats over there, you get the picture).


Each box contains the parts for a different core module, and from those core modules you can create any Range configuration. We'll unpack each box one at a time, and build each module separately. Once all of the modules are built, you'll connect them to configure your Range seating piece.

Here's the most important thing right now: look at the index on page 8 to find the one-page map that matches the configuration you're setting up (check your order confirmation email if you don't remember the exact name) and keep handy. It'll show you how many of each box you have. We recommend starting with the biggest box first (usually, a corner or one of the seats).





Building each module

Inline Seat

This box contains an Inline Seat module with a Wide Panel. This seat is always sandwiched between two other modules (unless you only purchased a single Range Seat), and the Wide Panel is the full width of the seat. You can identify the Wide Panel at a glance by the two alignment holes on the tabs (the Narrow Panels have four holes).





Inline Seat

There's only one position for an Inline Seat, so you don't need to worry about a left or right orientation. If you have one of these modules, there's only one set of instructions to follow.



- 1 Lay the Wide Panel flat on its back, so the tab is perpendicular to the floor.




- 2 Lower the Square Base Platform so that it's nested inside the tab. Line up the left and right edges of the platform and the panel so that they're flush with each other.



- 4 Put the partially-assembled Inline Seat module in its approximate final position, still lying on its back, and set aside any pieces you didn't use for later, when you connect this module to the others.




- 3 Push a hand screw through each of the alignment holes, and loosely turn to catch the threaded insert. You may have to tilt the platform back and forth, or lift it up slightly, in order to get the hand screw to catch the thread. We recommend loosely attaching both hand screws to get the alignment right, rather than fully tightening one before the other.










End Seat

This box contains an open-ended seat with a Narrow Panel as the backrest. It's different from an Inline Seat module because the Narrow Panel is slightly narrower than the width of the seat. You can identify the Narrow Panel at a glance by the four alignment holes on the tab (the Wide Panels only have two holes).

The steps change a little bit depending on whether or not the module is in the left or right position; take a look at your configuration map to find out which set of instructions to follow.




End Seat, Left

Not sure what this means? Grab your configuration map and match this module to the layout. If it's on the left side of your layout, follow these steps. If it's on the right, skip ahead a page. Your configuration may have End Seat modules on both the left and right, in which case you'll set up one of each.


- 1 Lay the Narrow Panel flat on its back, so the tab is perpendicular to the floor.




- 2 Lower the Square Base Platform so that it's nested inside the tab, and line up the right edges of the Narrow Panel and the platform so that they're flush with each other. The platform is slightly wider than the panel, so it will extend a couple inches on the left side.




- 3 The tab has two pairs of alignment holes that correspond with two threaded inserts along each edge of the platform (you can ignore the inserts on each of the four corners). With the right side of the platform flush with the right side of the panel, the left-most alignment hole of each pair should be lined up with the threaded inserts.



- 4 Push a hand screw through each of the alignment holes, and loosely turn to catch the threaded insert. You may have to tilt the platform back and forth, or lift it up slightly, in order to get the hand screw to catch the thread. We recommend loosely attaching both hand screws to get the alignment right, rather than fully tightening one before the other.




- 5 Put the partially-assembled End Seat module in its approximate final position, still lying on its back, and set aside any pieces you didn't use for later, when you connect this module to the others.




End Seat, Right

Not sure what this means? Grab your configuration map and match this module to the layout. If it's on the right side of your layout, follow these steps. If it's on the left, go back a page. Your configuration may have End Seat modules on both the left and right, in which case you'll set up one of each.


- 1 Lay the Narrow Panel flat on its back, so the tab is perpendicular to the floor.




- 2 Lower the Square Base Platform so that it's nested inside the tab, and line up the left edges of the Narrow Panel and the platform so that they're flush with each other. The platform is slightly wider than the panel, so it will extend a couple inches on the right side.




- 3 The tab has two pairs of alignment holes that correspond with two threaded inserts along each edge of the platform (you can ignore the inserts on each of the four corners). With the left side of the platform flush with the left side of the panel, the right-most alignment hole of each pair should be lined up with the two threaded inserts.



- 4 Push a hand screw through each of the alignment holes, and loosely turn to catch the threaded insert. You may have to tilt the platform back and forth, or lift it up slightly, in order to get the hand screw to catch the thread. We recommend loosely attaching both hand screws to get the alignment right, rather than fully tightening one before the other.




- 5 Put the partially-assembled End Seat module in its approximate final position, still lying on its back, and set aside any pieces you didn't use for later, when you connect this module to the others.











Corner Seat

This box contains an interior corner seat, with two Wide Panels (the Corner End Seat modules have one Wide Panel and one Narrow Panel). It always sits between two other modules; it's never at the end of a sectional configuration.




Corner Seat

There's only one position for a Corner Seat, so you don't need to worry about a left or right orientation. If you have one of these modules, there's only one set of instructions to follow.

- 1 Lay both of the Wide Panels flat on their backs, so the tabs are perpendicular to the floor.




- 2 Lower the Square Base Platform so that it's nested inside the tab of the left panel. Line up the left and right edges of the platform and the panel so that they're flush with each other.




- 3 Push a hand screw through each of the alignment holes, and loosely turn to catch the threaded insert. You may have to tilt the platform back and forth, or lift it up slightly, in order to get the hand screw to catch the thread. We recommend loosely attaching both hand screws to get the alignment right, rather than fully tightening one before the other. Once you can feel that they've caught the thread, securely tighten both hand screws.


- 4 Make sure the second Wide Panel is flush with the first one, and tilt the in-progress module so the platform is nested inside the tab of the second Wide Panel.




- 5 Line up the meeting edge of the two Wide Panels so that they're flush. The alignment holes on the second Wide Panel, on the floor, will line up with the threaded inserts on the platform.




- 6 Just like you did in step 3, push a hand screw through each alignment hole and turn loosely to catch the insert, tilting the platform back and forth or lifting up as necessary. Once both screws catch the thread, securely tighten them.




7 Now that both panels are connected to the platform, tilt the module so that it's sitting upright, with the platform on the floor and the panels standing up straight.




8 Grab a corner brace and two thumbscrews. There are two smaller threaded inserts near the inside top corner of each panel — you may have to fold back the cushion pocket to see them.



9 Use the thumbscrews to lock the corner brace in place. We recommend loosely catching the thread on each side to get the alignment right, rather than fully tightening one before the other. You can use the edge of a flat brace or a quarter to help tighten the thumbscrews, if needed.




10 Tilt the partially-assembled Corner Seat module so one of the Wide Panels is on the floor again, place it in its approximate final position, and set aside any pieces you didn't use for later, when you connect this module to the others.













Corner End Seat

This box contains a closed-end seat, with both a Wide Panel and Narrow Panel (which is typically in an 'armrest' position). The Wide Panel is the full width of the seat, and the Narrow Panel is slightly narrower. You can tell the two panels apart by the alignment holes on the tabs: the Wide Panels have two holes, and the Narrow Panels have four.

The steps change a little bit depending on whether or not the module is in the left or right position; take a look at your configuration map to find out which set of instructions to follow.




Corner End Seat, Left

Not sure what this means? Grab your configuration map and match this module to the layout. If it's on the left side of your layout, follow these steps. If it's on the right, skip ahead a page. Your configuration may have Corner End Seat modules on both the left and right, in which case you'll set up one of each.


- 1 Lay the Wide Panel flat on its back, so the tab is perpendicular to the floor.




- 2 Lower the Square Base Platform so that it's nested inside the tab. Line up the left and right edges of the platform and the panel so that they're flush with each other.




- 3 Push a hand screw through each of the alignment holes, and loosely turn to catch the threaded insert. You may have to tilt the platform back and forth, or lift it up slightly, in order to get the hand screw to catch the thread. We recommend loosely attaching both hand screws to get the alignment right, rather than fully tightening one before the other. Once you can feel that they've caught the thread, securely tighten both hand screws.




- 4 Lay the Narrow Panel on its back to the left of the in-progress module, with the tab perpendicular to the floor. Tilt the in-progress module so the platform is nested inside the Narrow Panel tab (the Wide Panel, already attached, will be in the air).




- 5 Line up the right edge of the Narrow Panel and the left edge of the Wide Panel so that they're flush. The tab on the Narrow Panel has two pairs of alignment holes; when the two panels are flush, the left-most holes of each pair will line up with the correct threaded inserts in the platform.




- 6 Just like you did in step 3, push a hand screw through each alignment hole and turn loosely to catch the insert, tilting the platform back and forth or lifting up as necessary. Once both screws catch the thread, securely tighten them.




7 Now that both panels are connected to the platform, tilt the module so that it's sitting upright, with the platform on the floor and the panels standing up straight.





8 Grab a corner brace and two thumb screws. There are two smaller threaded inserts near the inside top corner of each panel — fold back the cushion pocket to see them.



9 Use the thumbscrews to lock the corner brace in place. We recommend loosely catching the thread on each side to get the alignment right, rather than fully tightening one before the other. You can use the edge of a flat brace or a quarter to help tighten the thumbscrews, if needed.




10 Tilt the partially-assembled Corner End Seat module so the Wide Panel is on the floor again, place it in its approximate final position, and set aside any pieces you didn't use for later, when you connect this module to the others.





Corner End Seat, Right

Not sure what this means? Grab your configuration map and match this module to the layout. If it's on the right side of your layout, follow these steps. If it's on the left, go back to page 29. Your configuration may have Corner End Seat modules on both the left and right, in which case you'll set up one of each.


- 1 Lay the Wide Panel flat on its back, so the tab is perpendicular to the floor.




- 2 Lower the Square Base Platform so that it's nested inside the tab. Line up the left and right edges of the platform and the panel so that they're flush with each other.




- 3 Push a hand screw through each of the alignment holes, and loosely turn to catch the threaded insert. You may have to tilt the platform back and forth, or lift it up slightly, in order to get the hand screw to catch the thread. We recommend loosely attaching both hand screws to get the alignment right, rather than fully tightening one before the other. Once you can feel that they've caught the thread, securely tighten both hand screws.




- 4 Lay the Narrow Panel on its back to the right of the in-progress module, with the tab perpendicular to the floor. Tilt the in-progress module so the platform is nested inside the Narrow Panel tab (the Wide Panel, already attached, will be in the air).




- 5 Line up the left edge of the Narrow Panel and the right edge of the Wide Panel so that they're flush. The tab on the Narrow Panel has two pairs of alignment holes; when the two panels are flush, the right-most holes of each pair will line up with the correct threaded inserts in the platform.




- 6 Just like you did in step 3, push a hand screw through each alignment hole and turn loosely to catch the insert, tilting the platform back and forth or lifting up as necessary. Once both screws catch the thread, securely tighten them.




- 7 Now that both panels are connected to the platform, tilt the module so that it's sitting upright, with the platform on the floor and the panels standing up straight.





- 8 Grab a corner brace and two thumbscrews. There are two smaller threaded inserts near the inside top corner of each panel — fold back the cushion pocket to see them.



- 9 Use the thumbscrews to lock the corner brace in place. We recommend loosely catching the thread on each side to get the alignment right, rather than fully tightening one before the other. You can use the edge of a flat brace or a quarter to help tighten the thumbscrews, if needed.




- 10 Tilt the partially-assembled Corner End Seat module so the Wide Panel is on the floor again, place it in its approximate final position, and set aside any pieces you didn't use for later, when you connect this module to the others.




Platform Seat

This box contains the universal building block of the Range system: a square seat platform that can attach to the side of any other seat in the system. It also works as an ottoman — simply detach it from the rest of the sectional and move it about the room.






Instructions for a connected Platform Seat

Not sure what this means? Grab your configuration map and match this module to the layout. If your configuration has an attached, armless seat on either end, or in a chaise-like arrangement, follow these steps. If it's a freestanding ottoman, skip ahead.


- 1 Lay the Square Base Platform upside down on the floor.



- 2 Screw two legs (found in your Hardware box) into the threaded inserts at the corners of one side of the platform, as shown.




- 3 Put the partially-assembled module in its approximate final position, and set aside the cushion and any other pieces you didn't use for later.




Instructions for a freestanding ottoman

Not sure what this means? If your configuration includes a floating, disconnected ottoman, follow these steps. You can always attach your ottoman later, in a chaise-like arrangement. Follow the steps for a "connected Platform Seat" for that.


- 1 Lay the Square Base Platform upside down on the floor.



- 2 Screw four legs (found in your Hardware box) into each of the threaded inserts at the four corners of the platform, as shown.




- 3 Flip the platform upright and place the cushion on top, and place it in the room. You'll have a few extra pieces; hold on to these in case you ever decide to attach your ottoman to the rest of your Range configuration.




Table

This box contains an integrated table attachment. Each tabletop is half the width of a seat (but the same depth) so if you have a configuration with a corner table, you'll be connecting two tabletops to make a square.





Instructions for a side table

Not sure what this means? Grab your configuration map and check the position of your table module. If it's located on either the left or right end, follow these steps. If it's set in the corner, follow the instructions for a corner table.


- 1 Lay the tabletop upside-down on the floor. Grab two legs from the Hardware box.
- 2 Screw two legs into the threaded inserts in the two corners on one of the longer sides, as shown.
- 3 Put the partially-assembled table aside.




Instructions for a corner table

Not sure what this means? Grab your configuration map and check the position of your table module. If it's located in the corner, follow these steps. If it's connected to either end, follow the instructions for a side table.


- 1 Lay two tabletops upside-down on the floor, with the long edges flush with each other. It will create a square, so whether the gap is horizontal or vertical is up to you.




- 2 Grab two connection plates and one leg from the Hardware box. Place the plates across the gap, with the eye holes lined up with the threaded inserts along the edges of the tabletops, as shown below.




- 3 Loosely thread the hand screws through the eye holes on the plates. Once you can feel each screw catch the thread, you can fully tighten them.



- 4 Screw a leg into the threaded insert in the far back corner of the tabletop.




- 5 Put the partially-assembled Table module in its approximate final position, and set aside any pieces you didn't use for later, when you connect this module to the others.






Part IV

Setting up your Range

Connecting your modules


You're on the home stretch now. You should have a set of partially-assembled modules, all in their approximate final position in your room — and a bunch of extra connection plates, legs, and other hardware. Now, you'll connect each module to build your final Range configuration. This is where the configuration map is really important, so make sure you have that handy.

- 1 All of your modules, except Tables or Platform Seats, should be lying on their backs. Line them up in their approximate final position — like your sofa or sectional got tipped over.




- 2 If you have a sofa configuration with your seats in a straight line, or anything with a Platform Seat in a chaise-like position, you should have one long 'bench' section. Push the modules together so that they're flush. If you have a sectional configuration — basically, any layout that has a right angle when you look at your configuration map — separate the modules into separate 'bench' sections.

For example, one 'bench' might have a left End Seat, an Inline Seat, and a Corner Seat; and another 'bench' could have an Inline Seat and a right Corner End Seat. You'll connect the modules to build each bench separately, and connect them at the very end.




- 3 Take a close look at your configuration map. Count out how many leg & connection plate assemblies you'll need (rule of thumb: two for each gap between modules) and how many additional legs you'll need (one at every corner of your configuration).


- 4 Put together as many leg & connection plate assemblies as you need by removing the plastic cap from the leg, screwing it into the middle of the convex side of the plate, and replacing the plastic cap on the other side.




- 5 Use the hand screws inserted through the eye holes on each leg & plate assembly to connect the bottom of each module, carefully following your configuration map as a guide. If you have a sectional, figure out where the benches will connect, and attach the leg & plate assemblies so they're hanging off the edge where the two benches meet. After you flip the bench sections upright, the end that doesn't have legs will rest on those two plates.




- 6 Gather the flat braces and thumbscrews that you didn't use before, and use them to connect any Wide and Narrow Panels, while they're still resting on the ground. The concave side of the braces will face in.




- 7 With a partner, flip everything upright. If you have a sectional configuration, or need to attach a Platform Seat in a chaise-like position, rest the edge of the module that doesn't have legs on top of the leg & plate assemblies protruding from the other bench. Reach underneath and securely connect it with hand screws.



- 8 Tables have a slightly different pattern of legs and plates, but as long as you follow your map, you can treat them as you would any other module.



- 9 If you have a sectional configuration, once the bench sections are upright and connected underneath, you'll need a final flat brace (or two) to connect the panels. Use two more thumbscrews and remember that the concave side of the brace faces in. Then, you're ready to place your cushions.




Placing and perfecting your cushions

At this point, you should have the frame of your Range configuration nestled in the exact spot in your room where it'll live — and a big pile of seat cushions and cushion inserts off to the side. All that's left is to put the soft parts of your sofa or sectional in their place. You're so close!


- 1 Each seat cushion is a perfect square, so they can go on any of the seat platforms. Our only tip is to make sure the zipper side isn't facing out.

Put cushion inserts into the pockets


- 1 There are two sizes of cushion inserts, wide and narrow, that correspond with the two widths of the different panels. Wide inserts go in the pockets attached to the Wide Panels and narrow inserts go in the pockets attached to the Narrow Panels.



- 2 Use the drawing below to orient the inserts properly: they have a slight teardrop shape, and the bottom of the teardrop goes toward the bottom of the cushion, which is facing you when the pockets are flipped back. The "wide" and "narrow" labels that are stitched onto the inserts and inside the pockets match up, so if you had x-ray vision, they would line up with each other.




- 3 Make sure the fill is stuffed evenly through the pocket — you might need to work with it a bit — and zip up the pocket.




- 4 Flip it back over. They might look a bit uneven at first; after a few movie marathons or weekend gamedays, they'll start to even out.

Adjust the corner cushions


- 1 To get that crisp line between your two corner cushions, fold them both back.



- 2 Then, simultaneously fold them into position, holding the innermost corner together with your hand.



- 3 Keep a hold of the two corners, and really stuff it into the corner of the module as best you can. Again, it might take some time for the filling to even out, so be patient with it — it'll be comfortable no matter what.
