

# MASKSTODAGE



# PROPER FIT INSTRUCTIONS:


For proper use, follow these steps each time mask is worn.

- 1. Elastic straps should be pre-stretched before placing mask on the face (Fig. 1).
- 2. Cup the mask in your hand, with the mask nosepiece in your fingertips, cupping in your hand, allowing elastic straps to hang freely (Fig. 2).
- 3. Align mask under chin with the nosepiece facing up. Pull each strap over your ears, allowing it to rest behind each ear. (Fig. 3).
- 4. Use both hands to align nosepiece over nose and adjust the nosepiece to fit the shape of your nose comfortably by pushing nosepiece inward. Using your fingers, secure the nosepiece down on both sides (Fig. 4). ALERT! Not properly securing the nosepiece by only using one hand may result in improper fit, decreased filtration, and mask contamination. Use two hands to secure nosepiece.
- 5. Check nosepiece for proper seal before using. Place both hands completely over the mask and exhale deeply to check proper mask-to-face seal. Do not disturb mask position during seal check. For noticeable air leaks around face or nose, readjust nosepiece described above. For mask air leaks along edges, adjust elastic straps (Fig. 5).
- 6. Only enter contaminated areas once mask has achieved a proper seal. DO NOT use in contaminated areas without proper sealing.






