

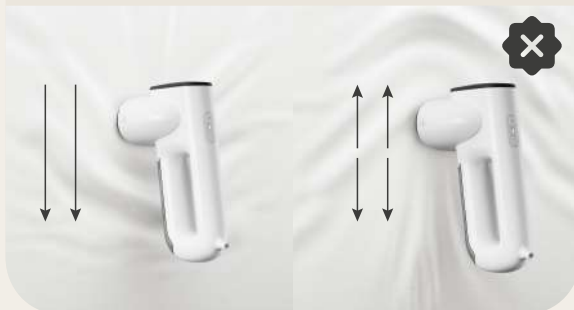
5 TIPS TO ENSURE A SMOOTH FIRST USE

Neakasa Magic 1
Vacuum Steamer

TIPS 1

Using suction ironing mode, you'll achieve smoother, faster results. This is ideal for thicker fabrics or garments that require a neat finish, like T-shirts, shirts, jeans, suits and similar items.

⚠ In suction ironing mode, move the steamer slowly from top to bottom—avoid back-and-forth movements for best results.



TIPS 2

As you move the steamer down, let the clothes hang naturally. Keeping the steamer parallel to the clothes will give you the smoothest results.

⚠ Avoid tilting the steam plate at an angle to the clothes.



TIPS 3

If you prefer ironing on a board, be sure to turn off the suction function.

⚠ With the suction off, use the steamer like a traditional iron—ideal for soft or textured fabrics and garments.



TIPS 4

If you don't want to disturb the natural texture of the fabric, turn off the suction function. Keep a certain distance between the steamer and the clothes, allowing the steam to gradually soften the fabric. This process will take a bit longer.



TIPS 5

The steam plate contains a filter sponge that collects loose fibers and lint from the clothes. Depending on usage frequency, it needs to be cleaned every 3 to 5 months. If you notice reduced suction power, open the side slot of the steam plate to remove the filter sponge. Rinse it with water, let it dry completely, and then reinstall it. Press the steam plate to ensure it's securely in place.

Filter Sponge





- 1 **LONG PRESS:** Power On / Off (30s preheat)
SHORT PRESS: Pause / Work
(Green light flashing) / (Red light steady on)
- 2 **SHORT PRESS** to turn on suction
- 3 Contains a **FILTER SPONGE** that needs regular rinsing
- 4 Move downwards to remove the water tank
- 5 Use **DISTILLED WATER** or **PURIFIED WATER** to reduce limescale build up

Indicator Light	Status	Description
Light off	Powered off	The device is in the off state; In the on state, if there is no operation for 10 minutes, it will automatically power off.
Red/Green light alternates flashing	Preheating	The boiler is heating up. The preheating lasts for 30 seconds. After that, the water pump will start working and enter low steam mode.
Red light steady	Steam mode	
Green light flashing	Pause mode	The device is paused. Press the power button to resume operation.
