




Before using your new product, please read these instructions to prevent any damage.

- 1 START HERE**  
How do I attach the stand to my TV? (not for wall mounting)  
You'll need: Soft surface and Phillips screwdriver
- A Place your TV face-down on a cushioned, clean surface.
  - B Align the screw holes on the TV stands with the holes on the bottom of your TV, then secure each stand to your TV with two of the provided screws.



- WALL MOUNT**  
How do I prepare my TV for wall mounting? (not for use with a TV stand)  
You'll need: Soft surface and Phillips screwdriver  
Before you mount your TV, make sure that:
- You remove the stands.
  - The bracket supports the weight of your TV.
- A Carefully place your TV face-down on a cushioned, clean surface.
  - B See the instructions that came with your wall mount for more information about how to correctly mount your TV.



**VESA Mounting Pattern**  
VESA mount (mm): 100 x 100 – M4 type screws\*  
\* minimum 10mm/maximum 12mm

Your TV has four VESA mounting holes on the back. If you attach a wall-mount bracket to the back of your TV, **the bracket must be securely attached, using all four holes.** If you do not use all four mounting holes, your TV may fall and cause property damage or personal injury. See the documentation that came with your wall-mount for complete mounting instructions.





How do I connect my TV to external speakers?


### USING DIGITAL AUDIO

### USING ANALOG AUDIO





## 4 TURNING ON MY TV


When can I turn on my TV?

### WHEN YOUR TV IS IN PLACE:

**1** Plug the power cord into a power outlet.



**2** Remove the remote control cover and install the batteries.




**3** Press  on your remote control.
