

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Introduction

Congratulations on your purchase of a high-quality Insignia product. Your NS-HTMS1 represents the state of the TV stand design and is designed for reliable and trouble-free performance.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read through these instructions completely to be sure you're comfortable with this easy install process. Also check your TV owner's manual to see if there are any special requirements for mounting your TV.


Assembly instructions

Step 1 – Determine whether your TV has a flat back or an irregular or obstructed back


- 1 Carefully place your TV face-down on a cushioned, clean surface to protect the screen from damages and scratches.
- 2 Temporarily lay the horizontal brackets (01) on the back of your TV.
- 3 Align the screw holes in the brackets (01) with the mounting screw holes on your TV.
- 4 Identify which type of back your TV has:
 - **Flat back:** The brackets lay flush against the back of your TV and do not block any jacks. You do not need spacers when assembling your stand.



- **Obstructed back:** The brackets (01) block any of the jacks on the back of your TV. You need the spacers (22 mm or 2.5 mm) when assembling your stand.



- **Irregularly-shaped back:** There is a gap between the brackets (01) and some part of the back of your TV. You need the spacers (22 mm or 2.5 mm) when assembling your stand.



- 5 Remove the brackets (01).

Step 2 – Select screws, washers, and spacers

- 1 Select the hardware for your TV (screws, washers, and spacers). A limited number of TVs come with mounting hardware included. (If screws came with your TV, they are almost always in the holes on the back of your TV.) If you don't know the correct length of the mounting screws your TV requires, test various sizes by hand threading the screws.

Select the screws that fit:



M4 × 12 mm screw	M4 × 35 mm screw
M6 × 12 mm screw	M6 × 35 mm screw
M8 × 16 mm screw	M8 × 35 mm screw
M8 × 25 mm screw	M8 × 50 mm screw

Use the M4 washers with the M4 screws. Use the M6/M8 washers with the M6 or M8 screws.

For an irregular or obstructed TV back, also use the 2.5 mm spacers, 22 mm spacers or a combination of the 2.5 mm and 22 mm spacers. You can combine spacers (22 mm or 2.5 mm) for extra length.

⚠ CAUTION: To avoid potential personal injuries and property damage, make sure that the screws have adequate threads to secure the brackets to your TV. If you encounter resistance, stop immediately and contact customer service. Use the shortest screw and spacer combination to accommodate your TV. Using hardware that is too long may damage your TV. However, using a screw that is too short may cause your TV to fall from the stand.



- 2 Remove the screws.
- 3 For a flat back TV, go to [Step 3 – Option 1: Attach the horizontal brackets to a flat-back TV](#) on page [9](#).
-OR-
For an irregular or obstructed back, go to [Step 3 – Option 2: Attach the horizontal brackets to an obstructed or irregularly-shaped TV back](#) on page [10](#).


Step 3 – Option 1: Attach the horizontal brackets to a flat-back TV

You'll need



⚠ CAUTION: Avoid potential personal injuries and property damage! DO NOT use power tools for this step. Tighten the screws only enough to secure the TV bracket to your TV. DO NOT over tighten the screws.

- 1 Align the holes on the horizontal brackets (**01**) with the screw holes on the back of your TV. Make sure that the brackets are centered horizontally.
- 2 Place the washers you selected in Step 2 – Select screws, washers, and spacers over the holes in the brackets that align with the screw holes on the back of your TV, then insert the screws you selected in Step 2 – Select screws, washers, and spacers through the washers. Make sure that the horizontal brackets (**01**) are level.
- 3 Tighten the screws until they are snug against the horizontal brackets (**01**). Make sure that the horizontal brackets (**01**) are securely fastened before moving on to the next step.




Step 3 – Option 2: Attach the horizontal brackets to an obstructed or irregularly-shaped TV back






Washers (select 1 set)



Spacers




Note: You can combine spacers for extra length.



CAUTION: Avoid potential personal injuries and property damage! DO NOT use power tools for this step. Tighten the screws only enough to secure the TV bracket to your TV. DO NOT over-tighten the screws.

- 1 Place the spacers you selected in [Step 2 – Select screws, washers, and spacers](#) over the screw holes on the back of your TV.
- 2 Align the holes on the horizontal brackets (01) with the holes in the spacers. Make sure that the horizontal brackets (01) are centered horizontally.
- 3 Place the washers you selected in [Step 2 – Select screws, washers, and spacers](#) over the holes in the horizontal brackets (01) that align with the screw holes on the back of your TV, then insert the screws you selected in [Step 2 – Select screws, washers, and spacers](#) through the washers and spacers. Make sure that the horizontal brackets (01) are level.
- 4 Tighten the screws until they are snug against the brackets(01). Make sure that the horizontal brackets (01) are securely fastened before moving on to the next step.



Step 4 – Attach the vertical bracket

You'll need



14 - Vertical bracket (1)





10-32 × 3/8 in.
Interface screw (4)



Phillips screwdriver

- 1 Center the vertical bracket (**14**) on the back of your TV.
- 2 Secure the vertical bracket (**14**) to the horizontal brackets (**01**) with four 10-32 × 3/8 in. interface screws.
- 3 Tighten the screws until they are snug against the vertical bracket (**14**). Make sure that all the brackets (**01** and **14**) are securely fastened before moving on to the next step.



Step 5 – Attach the post to the base**You'll need****16** - Post (1)**17** - Base (1)


1/4-20 x 3/8 in. Lock screw (2)





Note: The base (17) is made of plastic with steel structuring underneath. It has rubber feet which prevent it from sliding.

- 1 Insert the post (16) into the hole on the base (17).



- Secure the post (16) to the base (17) with two 1/4-20 x 3/8 in. lock screws. Make sure that the post (16) is securely fastened before moving on to the next step. Do not over-tighten the screws.



Step 6 – Attach your TV to the post

You'll need



1/4-20 x 3/8 in. Lock screw (2)






HEAVY! You may need assistance with this step.

- 1 Determine the height where you want to hang your TV.


Note: If you have a soundbar attached to the bottom of your TV, make sure that you select a height on the stand that allows room for the soundbar.




Examples of the highest and lowest hanging positions:



- 2 Carefully hang the TV/bracket assembly on the post (16).




- 3 Secure the TV/bracket assembly to the post (16) with two 1/4-20 x 3/8 in. lock screws. Make sure that the assembly is securely fastened before moving on to the next step. Do not over-tighten the screws.




Step 7 – Manage cables

- Route your cables through the front or top opening in the post (16), then out the back.



Step 8 – Adjust the TV viewing angle

- Hold the sides of your TV and swivel your TV left or right.



If you ever need to remove your TV from the post






HEAVY! You may need assistance with this step.

- 1 Remove the two 1/4-20 x 3/8 in. lock screws that secure the TV/bracket assembly to the post (16).



- 2 Carefully lift the assembly up and off the post (16).

How long does the coverage last?

The Warranty Period lasts for 1 year (365 days) from the date you purchased the Product or the date of delivery (if later than the date of purchase). Your purchase date is printed on the receipt you received with the Product. In the event that Authorized Partner ceases to sell the covered Insignia branded product, this warranty shall terminate for that product and there shall be no repair or replacement of the Product.

What does this warranty cover?

During the Warranty Period, if the original manufacture of the material or workmanship of the Product is determined to be defective by an authorized Insignia repair center or store personnel, Insignia will (at its sole option): (1) repair the Product with new or rebuilt parts; or (2) replace the Product at no charge with new or rebuilt comparable products or parts. Products and parts replaced under this warranty become the property of Insignia and are not returned to you. If service of Products or parts are required after the Warranty Period expires, you must pay all labor and parts charges. This warranty lasts as long as you own your Insignia Product during the Warranty Period. Warranty coverage terminates if you sell or otherwise transfer the Product.

How to obtain warranty service?

If you purchased the Product at a Best Buy retail store location or from a Best Buy online website (www.bestbuy.com or www.bestbuy.ca), please take your original receipt and the Product to any Best Buy store. Make sure that you place the Product in its original packaging or packaging that provides the same amount of protection as the original packaging. If you purchased your Product from an Authorized Partner, call Insignia at 1-877-467-4289.

To obtain warranty service, in the United States and Canada call 1-877-467-4289. Call agents may diagnose and correct the issue over the phone.

If you purchased the Product from an Authorized Partner other than Best Buy, please call 1-888-BESTBUY in the United States or 1-866-BESTBUY in Canada. You will be asked to provide proof of purchase and to return your Product to Best Buy. Make sure that you put the Product in its original packaging or packaging that provides the same amount of protection as the original packaging.

Where is the warranty valid?

This warranty is valid only in the United States and Canada to the original purchaser of the product from an Authorized Partner, in the country where the original purchase was made.

What does the warranty not cover?

This warranty does not cover:

- Food, beverage, and/or medicine loss/spoilage.
- Damage to other products caused by a power surge or other similar issue while connected to the Product.
- Customer instruction/education.
- Installation.
- Set up adjustments.
- Cosmetic damage.
- Damage due to weather, lightning, and other acts of God, such as power surges.
- Accidental damage.
- Misuse.
- Abuse.
- Negligence.
- Commercial purposes/use, including but not limited to use in a place of business or in communal areas of a multiple dwelling condominium or apartment complex, or otherwise used in a place of other than a private home.
- Modification of any part of the Product, including the antenna.
- Display panel damaged by static (non-moving) images applied for lengthy periods (burn-in).
- Damage due to incorrect operation or maintenance.
- Connection to an incorrect voltage or power supply.
- Damage due to attempted repair by any person not authorized by Insignia to service the Product.
- Products sold "as is" or "with all faults".
- Consumables, including but not limited to batteries (i.e. AA, AAA, C etc.).
- Products where the factory applied serial number has been altered or removed.
- Loss or Theft of this product or any part of the product.
- Display panels containing up to three (3) pixel failures (dots that are dark or incorrectly illuminated) grouped in an area smaller than one tenth (1/10) of the display size or up to five (5) pixel failures throughout the display. (Pixel based displays may contain a limited number of pixels that may not function normally.).
- Failures or Damage caused by any contact including but not limited to liquids, gels or pastes.
