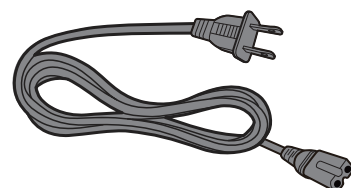

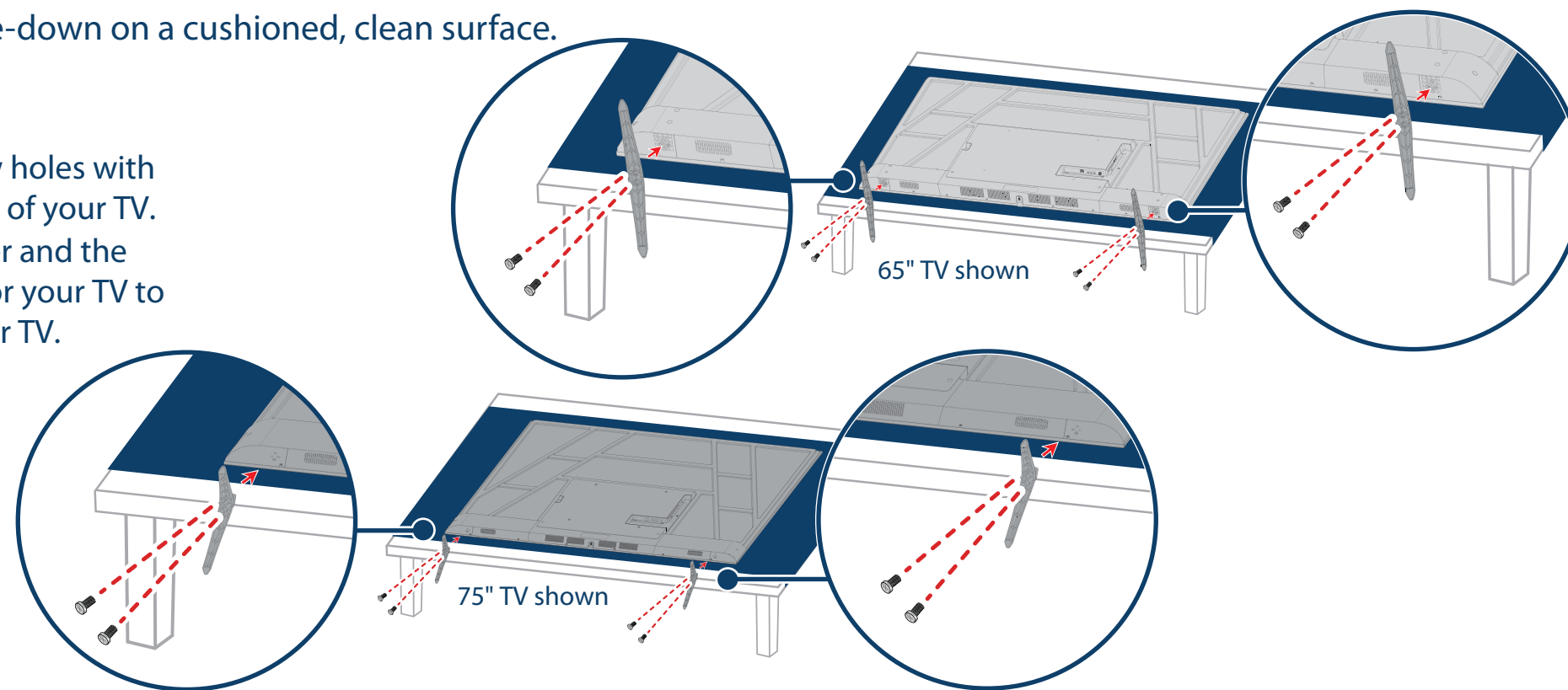
Before using your new TV, read these instructions to prevent any damage. Do not plug your power cord in until all other devices have been connected.

1 INSTALLING THE STANDS OR A WALL MOUNT

Place your TV face-down on a cushioned, clean surface.

STANDS

- 1 Align the TV stand screw holes with the holes on the bottom of your TV.
- 2 Use a Phillips screwdriver and the four screws (included) for your TV to secure the stands to your TV.



WALL MOUNT

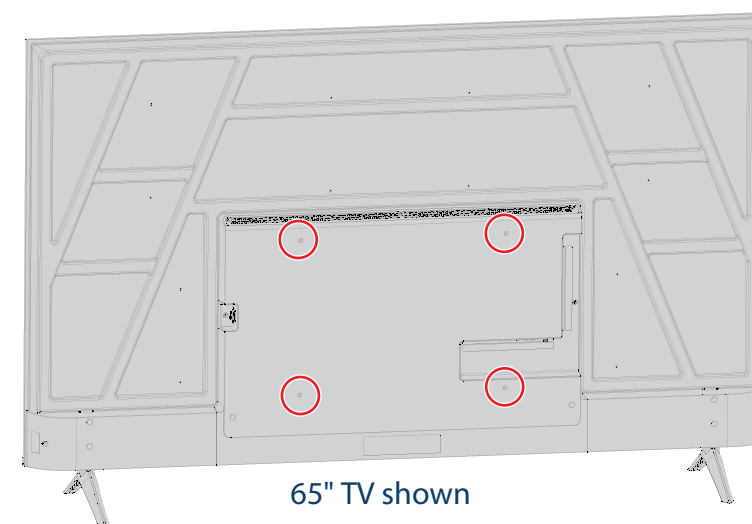
Before you mount your TV, make sure that:

- Stands are not attached to your TV.
- The wall-mount bracket supports the weight of your TV.

See the instructions that came with your wall mount for more information about how to correctly mount your TV.

⚠ WARNING: Your TV has four VESA mounting holes on the back. **You must secure a wall-mount bracket to all four holes.** If you do not use all four holes, your TV may fall and cause property damage or personal injury.

Note: Wall-mount screws are not included.



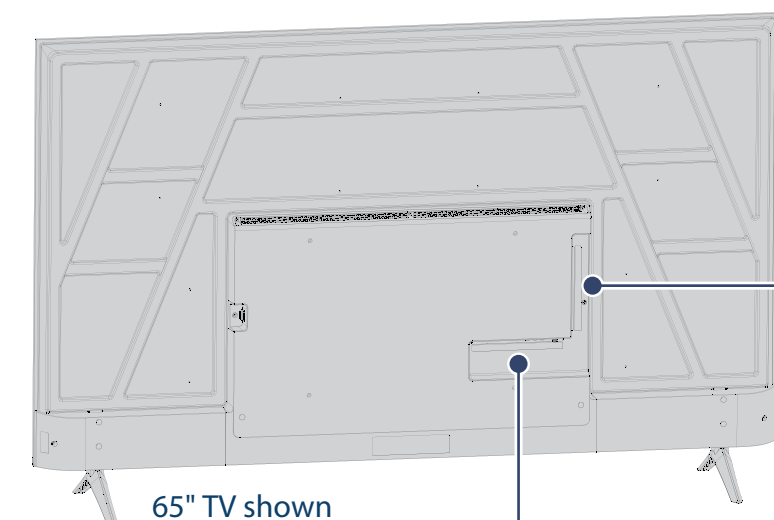

Note: You can use HDMI to connect to other HDMI devices. To use eARC/ARC functionality the connected device must also have HDMI eARC/ARC.

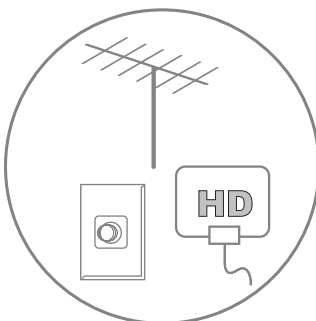

AUDIO OPTIONS



You can use the **DIGITAL OPTICAL OUTPUT** jack or the **HDMI1 (eARC/ARC)** jack.
Note: If you need to change the digital audio format, go to the **Home** menu, select **Settings**, then select **Display & Sounds**. Select **Audio Output**, then select **Digital Audio Format** and change the setting to **PCM** or your preferred audio format.

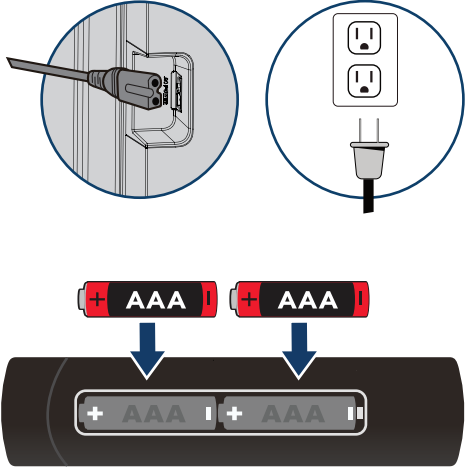
ETHERNET (optional)

ETHERNET

Note: You can use a wired Ethernet connection to access the internet instead of a Wi-Fi connection. Plug an Ethernet cable into the **ETHERNET** jack on your TV and your Ethernet connection.

3 TURNING ON YOUR TV

1 Plug the power cord (included) into the back of your TV and a power outlet.



2 Remove the battery cover on the remote, install two AAA batteries (included), then replace the battery cover.

Tip: Always replace dead batteries with two brand-new AAA batteries from the same manufacturer. Never use damaged batteries. If your remote gets hot during use, stop using and contact customer support immediately.

3 Press the  (Power) button on your Voice Remote with Alexa.

4 Follow the on-screen instructions.

4 COMPLETING THE ON-SCREEN SETUP

Your TV should automatically pair to your new Voice Remote with Alexa.

Note: A stable internet connection is required in order to complete the on-screen setup.

1 If your remote is not paired, long press the  (Home) button for five seconds or until paired. If you continue to have issues, re-insert or replace the batteries and try again.

2 Select your Wi-Fi network from the displayed network list.

Note: If your Wi-Fi network is password protected, enter your network password using the on-screen keyboard. If your network is hidden, select the **Join Other Network** tile.*

3 Select your experience: **Full** (recommended) or **Basic**.

- Select **Full** to access live TV, over tens of thousands of streaming movies and TV episodes, thousands of apps, and Alexa skills. To get started, sign into or sign up for a free Amazon account.
- Select **Basic** to access live TV and the five preset streaming apps. Alexa and the full App Store are not included.

4 If you connected your TV to an antenna or cable wall jack:

A Go to **Settings > Live TV > Channel Scan**.

B Follow the on-screen instructions to scan for channels.

Note: To browse and watch live TV, use the **On Now** row or press the  (Guide) button on your Voice Remote with Alexa.
