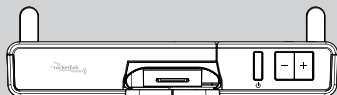




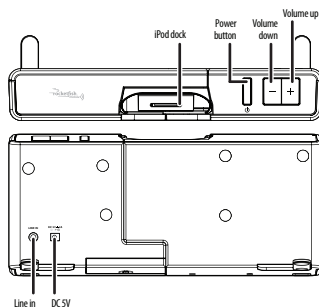
Convertible Speaker Dock

Connecting power

- Plug the AC adapter into the DC 5V jack on the back of your speaker dock and into a power outlet.

OR

- Insert four AAA batteries (not included) into the battery compartment.

Note: When you operate your speaker dock on battery power, it does not charge a docked iPod or iPhone battery.

QUICK SETUP GUIDE

Docking an iPod or iPhone

- 1 Select and insert the correct adapter for your iPod or iPhone.
Note: The adapters are marked. Make sure the correct dock adapter is used to avoid damage to the dock connector.)
- 2 Insert your iPod or iPhone into the dock.
- 3 Press  to turn on your speaker dock.
- 4 Press  on the remote control or on the docked iPod or iPhone to start playing a music or video file.
- 5 To control playback:
 - Press  to pause or resume playback.
 - Press  to turn off the speaker sound. Press again to turn the sound back on.
 - Press  or  to go to the previous or next file.
 - Press and hold  or  to search backward or forward in a file.
 - Press  (repeat) once to repeat the current file. Press twice to repeat the entire album or playlist. Press three times to turn off the repeat feature.
 - Press  (shuffle) to play files randomly. Press again to turn off the shuffle feature.
- 6 Press  to off your speaker dock.

Troubleshooting

Problem:	Solution:
Sound is not clear or there is no sound	Make sure that the iPod or iPhone is inserted correctly and that you are using the correct adapter.
No power	Make sure that the AC adapter is connected securely and correctly.
Sound is too low or too distorted	Press the VOLUME – button to turn down the volume.
Too much distortion	If you are using batteries, the battery charge may be low. Replace the batteries.
Cannot exit standby mode when playing music from an iPod	Make sure that there is no cable connected to the LINE IN jack.
iPod menu navigation does not work correctly	Make sure that your iPod or iPhone is not in landscape mode
